and raining the ship still at anchor at 6 A.M.
the watch returned on board at 8 sent the
watch ashore the middle part and latter
blowing a gale so ends

Monday Sep 26
Commences with a strong breeze the ship
still at anchor at 6 A.M. the watch returns
on board the middle and latter part fine
weather hands employed in taking water
and stowing down at 6 30 the watch
went ashore so ends

Tuesday Sep 27
Commences with fine weather the ship still
at anchor at 6 A.M. the watch returns on
board the middle and latter part of the day the
weather the same hands employed in taking
water and stowing up at 6 30 P.M. the
watch went ashore at 6 30 P.M.
