

Thursday Sept th 28 1904
 Commences with fine weather the ship
 still at anchor at 6 AM the watch returned
 a broad then midland latter part of the
 day the weather the same winds imploding
 painting and sending up top mast
 at 6 PM the watch went ashore
 so ends

 Brig Lerronea of New Bedford
 sent up four top mast
 at six PM watch
 went on shore

Friday Sept 30th
 sent up fore top masts
 mast set up rigging
 at six PM port watch
 goes on shore

Saturday October 1st
 sent up yards fore
 yard and fore top sail yards
 at six PM starboard
 watch goes shore

October Sunday 2nd
 in harbor

Monday Oct 3
 all day employed
 in receiving stores
 and putting rigging

Tuesday Oct 4
 all day & work bending
 sails filling water
