

Saturday April 1st. 1905
Light S.S.W. saw porpoise.
Crew skinning for want
of better employment.
Lat. S. 8-52 Lon. E. 7-01

2nd.
Variable winds from S. saw
porpoise & shipjack only.

Lat. 9-11 S. Lon. 5-24 E.

3rd.
Moderate S. wind saw finback &
grampus. Mr. Johnson not feeling as well
tonight.
So ends? 9:38 - 4:14

Sunday 4th.
Moderate S.S.E. today sky overcast,
saw nothing. by heading S.W. by W.
on the wind. Lat. S. 10-24 Lon.

Wednesday 5th.
Moderate S.S.E. for most part, in
latter part hauled a little to eastward,
saw one steamer P.M.: sky overcast with
passing drizzle.
Mr. Johnson did not leave his room yesterday
or today. took nourishment well but looked
bad.

Lat. S. 11-37 Lon. E. 1-12

Thursday 6th.
Saw two steamers. Moderate by under
all sail by the wind. watch employed in both all
day stowing casks for water & floating about. Mr. Johnson
better today. Lat. S. 12-37 Lon. W. 15-mi.

Started each head
of log off empty head of for each.
Wait for water.

Friday 7th.
Moderate from S.S.E. by under
all sail by the wind. saw nothing.
Lat. 13-52 S. Lon. 1-35 W.

Saturday 8th.
Moderate S.S.E. saw nothing;
Took casks from fore hold, drove them
board them off, & stowed them for
water, this A.M. P.M. washed ship inside,
steering W.S.W. this past 24 hours.
Lat. S. 15-15 Lon. W. 34/2
At 12 M. kept off W.

Sunday 9th.
Fresh breeze from S.S.E. saw land
at daylight 35 miles off. had wind to
make anchorage; beat in. dropped anchor at
3:00 P.M. got doctor off & sent Mr. Johnson
to Hospital at 5:30 P.M. All St. Helena men
went ashore after getting ship straight. Mr.
Eldredge & Mr. Wheeler went ashore about 6 P.M.
for the evening. no one else ashore tonight.

Monday 10th.
Fine day: vessel at anchor crew
employed washing ship outside & scraping spars.
Starboard watch ashore for the night.

Tuesday 11th.
Still at anchor crew employed
stripping spars & continuing to next to water.
Discharged & paid off St. Helena men whose time
was expired. Sent Mr. Johnson's effects to Hospital.
Discharged Mr. Johnson today. Capt. ordered
no officers one being in Hospital & one time expired.
