8th. Moderate today, saw porpoise.

Lat. 25° S. employed getting out water pinnace & Lon. 33-2 (drying sails. fine & aft)

So ends.

9th. Moderate, saw nothing. course N.W. nothing of account doing.

10th. Moderate, squalls hanging about. saw nothing. compass course N.N.W.

So ends

11th. Light S.E. trades, saw nothing employed calking deck & odd jobs.

So ends with very light air at dark & sky looking squally course N.N.W. by compass.

All kinds of weather today ending with a calm at dark.

15th. Very light weather from Eastward saw nothing. stiff squall with rain lasting about two hours this Am.

So ends.

16th. Wind from N.E.; unsteady, with passing rain squalls. All sail. course N.W.

17th. Fresh N.E., with passing rain squalls. course N.W. all sail. saw nothing.

Lat. N. 6-30 Lon. W. 44-43

18th. Fresh trades, fine day. saw two finbacks. course N.W. by compass.

Lat. 8-15 Lon 47-21

19th. Fresh trades, fine day saw nothing. course N.W. until 5 P.M. then N.W. by m.

Lat. 9-51 Lon. 49-52 W.

20th. Fresh trades. saw three mastschooners going W. Course N.W. by m. at 4 P.M. kept N.W. by m.

Lat. N. 11-19 Lon. W. 52-29

21st. Moderate N.E. saw nothing.
