all sail (square), course N.W. kept
W $\frac{1}{2}$ N. at 6 P.M.

Tuesday 23rd. Moderate N.E. at 9:30
A.M. saw Barbados at 4:30 P.M. anchored
in Carlisle bay having taken pilot off Hastings.
found here barks Sunbeam & A.R. Tucker. got
mate from home Mr. Graice. also fourth mate
or boatsteerer J. Andrews. mate on board tonight
Andrews going ashore again. Mr. Eldridge, Mr.
Wheeler & Mr. Cooper also going ashore for the
night. watchman on board from shore.

Gerald Blackman also on shore for the night
to visit his parents.

So ends.

Wednesday 24th. Fresh trades. took
on board yams, potatoes, bread, peas & nut.
Men who went ashore returned at 7 A.M.
Holiday on shore today.

So ends.

Thursday 25th. Strong trades, took
wood, Irish potatoes, vegetables, from
shore. shipped mate & fourth mate or boatsteerer.
So ends this day.

Friday 26th Strong trades, got all
aboard & took anchor at 3:30 & went to
sea by the wind to westward of Barbados.

So ends this day.

Saturday 27th Strong breeze, all sail out head
ing N by W & N. by the wind at 4:30 P.M.
got stiff squall with hard rain. Lasting fif-
teen minutes. took in the gallant sail & set
topmast stay sail, main top sail. saw Barbados
at 6 P.M.

Potatoes, yams, bread, peas & nut.

Strong E.N.E. squally saw nothing.

29th.

Strong E.N.E. squally. at 12 M. run
into a pod of sperm whales. 2 whales went
to windward slowly. beat with ship all
afternoon without effect. did not lower.

So ends.

Tuesday 30th.

Moderate with light passing
squalls. saw nothing. larboard
boat all rigged. made new mast for
bow boat, she having carried away the
old one in Barbados.

So ends.

Wednesday 31st.

Light E.N.E. saw nothing. lay on
the wind starboard tack.

So ends this day.

Thursday June 1st.

Light E.S.E. saw nothing. em-
ployed at odd jobs. sent down fore
royal yard & stowed away the sail.

So ends.

Friday June 2nd

Light with passing squalls. saw
one humpback. hooked two large
dolphins lost them. employed at odd jobs.

So ends this day.

Saturday June 3rd.

Light to moderate S wind fine whaling
day. hard rain in night. saw a few
birds, one small albatross. few flycatchers. washed
up paint work aft & did a few odd jobs today.

So ends this day.
