

Friday Saturday June 16th. 1905

A.M. calm P.M. light air from W. spoke Big Sullivan three weeks from N. Bedford clear. saw porpoise, grampse, & a barkentine. at dark wind all died out.

John D. Garcia off duty had tussle.

Saturday 17th. Calm all last night & all day today Big Sullivan in sight also saw one steamer & grampse picked up a turtle. scraped off barnacles from ships bottom. & cleaning iron work & painting it.

So ends.

Sunday 18th A.M. nearly calm P.M. light from W. saw "Sullivan", merchant bark, steamer & killers. big on the wind going to S. strong N.E. current.

Monday 19th. Fresh W. "Sullivan" in weather beam saw nothing else. big on the wind going to S.

Tuesday 20th Strong W. moderating P.M. saw nothing. "Sullivan" on our weather. going S. all day. J. DeGarcia improving.

So ends

Wednesday 21st. Squally wind from W.S.W. to E.N.E. calm most part. saw beach twice in morning also porpoise. one steamer P.M.

So ends this day.

Thursday 22nd Very light E. saw one steamer. some drizzle & fog.

So ends.

Friday 23rd Very light E to S.E. saw porpoise grampse. tott seaweed, dolphin. cleaning lead chains & coal tarving them.

So ends.

Saturday 24th. Calm until 10 A.M. when commenced to air from W. increasing to a very light breeze at 2 P.M. saw grampse. painting iron repaired the galley sail & a boat rudder.

Sunday June 25th.

Light wind from S.W. to W. one light shower lasting five minutes. splendid seeing but no life in the water.

So ends

Monday 26th Moderate W.S.W. saw porpoise & one barkentine. big on the wind going to N.W. all sail during the day.

John Garcia on duty.

Tuesday 27th Wind W.S.W. light & P.M. with passing squalls. saw grampse only.

So ends.

B. Employed fleeting new casks from lower hold into the between decks & also fleeting the water to them.

Weds. 28th Mod. W.S.W. saw nothing. employed in hold fleeting around & filling salt water.

So ends

Thursday 29th Strong S.W. saw nothing. employed setting up shrocks & at odd jobs.

So ends this day.

Friday 30th Strong S.W. & squally with rain. saw nothing but two sail at 5-30 P.M. set up shrocks & flagged them.

Saturday July 1st. A.M. calm & squalls hanging around. P.M. wind E. & rainy. at 8 A.M. saw beach to W. but no wind. run to W. when got wind but saw nothing. P.M. saw Bk. Canton & Pedro Varela Capt. Aras came aboard at 8 P.M. for half an hour. gave him latest papers "Standards".

2 Squally & wind variable; settling at S.E. at daylight saw two whales close to ship. P. Varela who looked boat without success whale went to windward. Canton in sight. also saw merchant brig John Andrews off duty. rupture turns out to be a Babra. Poulitied it & give him solution of iodide of Potassium internally.
