 July 22 Fresh S.W. wind a little smoky. at 6:30 A.M. raised a large whale laying around. lowered at 7:15 soon after the whale started & worked to windward slowly. later on saw another. no success called boats aboard at 12:30 P.M. they got aboard at 2 P.M. also saw a sail to leeward. J. Caracas off duty had penis.
 So ends

23 Strong S.W. saw porpoise. squally at night.
 So ends this Sunday.

24 Stiff W.S.W. with squalls & rain sky overcast all day. saw nothing missing under short sail.

25 Mod. & smooth wind W. saw nothing. got out water, meat & lot of cloth for mate to make new boatsail.
 So ends.

26 Mod. & a little smoky saw a sulphur bottom & conch fish. saw a drift log took it on deck & a lot of fish came to ship with it. caught about 4 lbs.
 So ends this day.

27 Mod. S.W. saw nothing. rolled boat up on top of house & started to put new checks in also 3 boards. sewing on boat sail.
 So ends.

28 Fresh & squally thunder squalls. saw grampse. big beating to E.

29 Fresh S.W. to W. squally. saw conch fish, killers & grampse. finished repairing boat. sewing on boat sail.

30 A.M. calm P.M. light breeze with a couple of light squalls. at 1 P.M. saw two whales lowered four boats & got two alongside boats up at 8 P.M. after the boats struck saw two more whales. Mr. Eldredge struck one & then Mr. Ginn struck the other whale that we got. J. Caracas on duty.

July 31 Mod. S.W. saw nothing. but whaling task Wanderer Capt. Shively came on board at 6 P.M. cut the two whales got last case on board at 6:15 P.M.

So ends this day.

August 1st Stiff S.W. saw grampse. "Wanderer" went out of sight at 10 A.M. employed boiling.

So ends.

2nd. Strong & rugged. boiling finished at 9 P.M. saw down 30 lbs. at 11 A.M. saw whales close to ship. got foul of smoke & slick went to windward. lowered three boats without success.

So ends this day.

3rd. Strong & squally wind S.W. saw porpoise run down. balance of the oil. making mucky. So ends this day.

4th. Moderate gale from W.S.W. with stiff squalls of wind & rain. saw piece squid & drift log.
 So ends.

5th. Mod. S.W. with wind squalls & heavy rain. saw nothing but one steamed at dark came on raining & continued heavy all first part.
 So ends this day.

6th. Light W. saw one merchant bark in morning also saw grampse. clear today having a couple of light drizzle squalls.
 So ends another Sunday.

7th. Very light air from W. last part calm saw grampse & porpoise all day. finished putting in stanchion & piece of rail moved mainmast.
 So ends.

8th. Day light calm airing up. at 8 A.M. raised lone whale lowered four boats mate tried to go on whale saw boat chased & at night 5:30 P.M. Mr. Wheeler went on & the whale saw boat hit whale in head. came aboard at dark.

9th. Fair day. saw lone whale at 8:30 A.M. got him alongside at 3 P.M. Mr. Eldredge got him. cut until dark. put in head & chain.
