August. Light N.E. a little hazy. saw porpoise & Grampse. cut the whale started work at 12-30 P.M. got junk cut up & falls below. got supper at 6-30 P.M.

So ends this day.

11 Light N.E. at 6 A.M. raised whales. saw mine during the day. lowered at 4 P.M. struck one at 1-30 P.M. got him tied up & hoisted up at 4 P.M. saw steamer. So ends. Mr. Cooper struck this one.

12 Moderate N.W. cut in the whale 8 A.M. & hoisting saw porpoise. P.M. cut up the blubber & junks & ran oil. saw large beach just at night.

So ends this day.

13 Moderate N.W. saw grampse. finished hoisting 12 M. run the cork & got all hot oil in the tank. washed off decks at 6 P.M. strong S.E. current today.

So ends.

14 Light & Moderate N.W. wind with heavy swell. P.M. wind going to W. saw one steamer & grampse. ran balance of the oil. finished repairing the jib & bent it.

So ends.

15 Moderate W. wind. heavy swell. saw grampse.

So ends this day.

16 Moderate W.S.W. at 8 A.M. saw whales 9 M. ten most beautiful day for whaling & the most shameful whaling done by the mate Mr. Gracia. we got nothing.

17 Moderate W.S.W. saw whales at 6 A.M. lowered at 7 V. Mr. Eldredge struck one got him fast & hoisted up at 12 M. mate got stove bad on the keel. saw a steamer. took the head off & on deck. bailed the case after 7 P.M. two boats went after another whale but no go. got aboard at 2-30 P.M. started the work at 3 P.M.

So ends this day.

1905 Strong & rugged. saw grampse. took body of whale in. then replaced carboard boat with one off the house. hoisting.

saw three sail. wind S.

19 Moderate W. dying to calm at night. saw a drift log & grampse. run down the oil. re-nailed starboard boat & worked on carboard boat.

So ends.

20 Calm until 4 P.M. then light air from S.S.E. saw grampse & porpoise. also one steamer.

So ends this Sunday.

21 Moderate & smooth. clear. wind S.E. saw grampse & one steamer. repairing boat on the house.

So ends this day.

22 Moderate S.E. clear & smooth. saw grampse porpoise. fist. bottom of a wrecked frigate & one steamer. worked on stove on boat.

23 Moderate S.E. under all sail smooth & clear saw grampse. finished repairing carboard boat & gave her a coat of paint.

So ends this day.

24 Light S. smooth & clear. 5 P.M. hauling in to W. with light rain squalls around & at dark calm. saw grampse.

25 Very light S. air. saw grampse. repaired jib.

So ends.

26 Very light S. morning calm. some rain. put overboard carboard boat & put spar on the house. saw blackfish porpoise grampse dolphins & tide rips.

So ends.

27 Fresh & squally. wind S.W. broke a link in outer jib grampse set it up with a lanyard & also put a preventer on the jib grampse. saw con fish & grampse.

So ends.

28 Strong & rugged. saw nothing but whaling. big "Sullivan" went on board of her & got the news in the morning. bent new main stay sail. Sullivan towing down sail.
