Nov. 9th. harring royal. Steering S. employed stowing
oil in fore peak & hooking off ~~cast~~

So ends this day.

" 10 Strong E.N.E. ships head S. all sail harring
royal finished stowing the oil. this whale
made us 90 bbls. oil. J. De. Mello. Valfred
Gibo off duty same complaint pain in
stomach.

So ends this day.

11th. Strong E.N.E. brig heading S. under all sail
harring royal. Employed picking tier of salt
water for hold starboard side in readiness
for restowing oil. J. De. Mello on duty

So ends Saturday.

12th. Strong E.N.E. at 12 M. took in light sail
& luffed to wind. on port tack. at 5:30 P.M. set
top gallant sail & royal and kept S.S.W. saw
nothing Alfred Gibo.

So ends this day.

13th. Moderate N.E. today. cleaned jaw bones &
whales teeth today. at 7 P.M. luffed to wind
took in sail & let head yards come aback.

So ends.

14th. Light N.E. at 5 AM. kept W. S.W. at 7:30 AM.
saw St. Vincent at 10 anchored at Porto Grande
St. Vincent. at 11 P.M. started to break out for hold.

So ends

15th. Fresh trades. employed breaking out
oil & restowing. found seams open on starboard
side under chain plates ~~more~~ more than in
elsewhere.

So ends

16th. Light trades. employed on oil &
caulking ship. So ends

17th. AM. calm P.M. Light wind from south
caulked ship. I worked on oil. ready for sea
at night but no wind to get out.

So ends

1905-
Nov. 18 At daylight calmy 10 AM. got light breeze
from N.W. went to work on oil at 7 AM.
not being able to get out of harbour. at 8 P.M.
hove up anchor & went to sea, very light air from
S.E. hauling a little to S. at 10 P.M. watch went
below, having got port anchor on the bow & chif-
fanning out into the channel.

So ends this day.

19th. At daylight brig at a off end of St. Vincent
have been fanning along all day. light air &
calme. found five stowaways on board.
lashed ~~to~~ ^{to} anchors on bow & run down the
chain. Domingo Bono off duty. with venereal dis-
ease.

So ends.

20th. Light breeze at daylight, increasing to
fresh at dusk. employed restowing lower
hold. at 5 P.M. "Brava" bearing E by compass
15 miles distant. no watch below.

So ends.

21st. Strong N.E. wind. employed stowing lower
hold over. Manuel Gomes off duty since
Sunday. venereal disease.

So ends this day.

22nd. Strong N.E. employed stowing the
lower hold over. Frank Ramos off duty
having been slightly jammed by a rash
yesterday.

So ends.

23rd. Moderate N.E. sky overcast all day. em-
ployed stowing the lower hold anew. got the
last of the oil on deck today A.M. saw
porpoise.

& a steamer. finished stowing lower hold at
3 P.M. Manuel Ramos off duty with bad cold & head-
ache. Add ~~lighting~~ of Manuel Ramos at Anctur.
