Dec. 29 Fair day for whaling. saw one steamer employed in fishing.

30th. Good. N.E. stowed the oil. picked up a whale that we lost on 27th. cut him. Veritas off duty with asthma. Lat. 13-05 Lon 41-51

31st. Fresh. E.N.E. saw nothing. finished boiling the whale picked up at West night. run the oil today
Lat. 13-16 Lon 41-55

1906:

Jan 1st. Strong trades. saw nothing. sent the Lat N. Cook (John Nevil) out of the galley on account 13-21 of getting in incompetency. sent John Stevens Lat. N. in as cook. I will do boys work.

2nd. A.M. Fresh. E.N.E. P.M. moderate. nothing.

3rd. Light trades. saw porpoise & large truck just before dark, a long way off.

4th. Daylight air. saw five squid two finbacks grampus & what looked like four small whales. to windward this morning. did not lower only saw them once. SSSS more likely blackfish.

5th. Daylight all night heaved up at 6 A.M. from N.E. hauling to W at night. saw two finbacks & killer. big under all sail on eastern tack at dark.

6th. Moderate wind from N.E. 5 P.M. going to N.W. saw two finbacks. some swell. all sail.

7th. Calm today. saw one back a lot of blackfish. lowered two boats without success.

1906
Jan 8th. Got light breeze at daylight which continued through the day. saw nothing. big under all sail on northern tack. sent down royal yard. SSSS

9th. Strong trades. saw one finback.
Lat. 16-28 N. Lon. 46-21 W.

10th. Strong & rugged. more moderate at night. saw one finback. steering N.W. easy sail.

11th. Fresh trades. saw nothing. all sail N.W.
SSSS

12th. Strong trades. saw two finbacks. big going to W. all sail (square)
SSSSS

13th. Strong E.N.E. course W by N. all square sail. So ends this day.

14th. Strong E.N.E. saw nothing. course W by N. all sail.
Lat. N. 19-13 Lon. W. 56-23

15th. Strong E.N.E. equally at midday. saw porpoise course W by N. all square sail.
Lat. N. 19-23 Lon. W. 58-43

16th. Moderate trades. saw nothing all sail out steering N.W. by W.
Lat. N. 19-48 Lon. W. 61-05

17th. Moderate E. wind fine day after rain. saw nothing. course N.W.

18th. Moderate E. wind. saw two finbacks & a school of blackfish. course N.W.
Lat. N. 22-10 Lon. W. 64-34
