Feb. 17 Strong N.W.E. moderating at night some sea on.
 Looking. repaired waist boat & run two
 casks of oil. saw nothing. Antonio Souza
 off duty, fell & skinned leg & it is swollen.
 Mr. Gomes improving.

18th. ~~Am.~~ Calm! P.M. light air from N.E.
sky overcast & small rain at times. Fin-
ished with the whale tonight 5 P.M. ninety
one barrels with blubber. Saw nothing today.
At 2 a.m. was hailed by a steamer to know
if we were in distress.

Le ends this day.

19th. Very light N. today clear weather. saw porpoise
finback & white water reported long way to wind-
ward. Veriota off duty today Asthma spell.
Sold effects of M. Ramon at auction this
morning.

20th. Light & hazy wind going from N.E. to S.E. saw nothing. Cleaned jaw bones & teeth & got out water. very smooth sea.

21st. Fresh S.E. in morning increasing saw white
waters believe it to have been a finback.
P.M. wind S. blowing a gale some rain.

22nd. Blowing from N.W. moderating & going to N.
begin under lower top sail & staysails. 1 P.M. set
fore sail. saw two sail. pumps carefully
attended.

So ends this day.

23rd. Mod. N.W.E. with swell on. Brg on eastern
Tach. saw one Steamer & one Bark both going
to W. V. Lupa on duty but leg not healed.

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Feb. 24 Fresh N. a little E. big on eastern tack all head
sail but M. T. S. sail after 7-30 A.M. saw nothing.
dried cutting falls & refitted parcelling on pen-
santa.

25th. Light N. swell going down. saw nothing.
Brig on eastern tack.

26th. Mod. W. smooth sea. saw one finback. Tent
old jib topsail, fly jib & upper topsail. Drove okuni
in seam under fore chains that had worked loose
again. Big pumping about one hour & half to in
twenty four, when smooth sea on. steering E.

27th. Calm first part. Latter got breeze from S. then
S.W. with rain. over hauled the gullant
lefts & foot rope, also sent down Joursail to repair
font on ^{water} ~~chase~~ out ^{out} did finish on amount of rain. saw one fin
back. Blowing on. Love to on started and took at 11.30

28th. Blowing strong from W. today. running under
whole topsail. course E. took in upper topmast 8 P.M.

March 14. Strong W. set upper topsail at 7.30 Am. moder-
ating. M. set top gallant sail at 2 P.M. saw
one steamer.

2nd Light W.W. going to N.E. by S.P.M. saw one
finback. put Peter J. Silva in irons for as-
saulting Mr. Eldredge. finished repairing
foresail & bent it.

3rd. Good whole sail breeze from E. saw nothing
big on southern tack. at 6 P.M. wind hauled
to E.E. & wore ship. Took irons off P.J. Silva.
Manuel Gomes slipped. I hurt myself & is
off duty again.
