April 22nd. Fine day. Port watch on shore on liberty for twenty four hours from 7 A.M. today. Had Boss Carpenter examine stern of ship & other parts for an opinion as to the condition of bow generally.

23rd. Fine day. crew employed scrubbing ship outside, scraping down spars & cleaning iron head chains. Had the Consul's clerk to come aboard & sign straggles. sent Frank Ramos and Manuel Gomes ashore to Consul's office to satisfy them in regard to expired term of service. The following men overstayed their leave on shore D. Pardo M. Moncillo, John Vera, Antonio Souza Alfred Serpa.

24th. Fine day. employed about ship. took out starboard pump overhauled & painted it & put it back. Port watch sent ashore 6 P.M. D. Pardo, M. Moncillo, John Vera refused duty & mate put them in irons.

25th. Fine day. Took irons off the three men. crew employed overhauling foretop & lifts & odd jobs. got a new pump for ship & put it in forward. carpenter made mold for new breast book. Discharged Mr. Eldredge as per agreement. Starboard watch ashore for the night. Antonio Silveira not on board today.

26th. Fine day. mod. winds. employed painting yards mast & etc. Carpenters at work on breast hook & caulkers on starboard side. watch ashore at night.

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April 27th. Mod. trades. crew employed painting yards mast tops & etc. Carpenters at work on breast hook & caulkers finished work under fore rigging on starboard side. Mr. Eldredge left by S.S. "Dominic" for N.Y. Antonio Silveira has not returned. got out a warrant for him & also reported him to U.S. Consul.

Watch ashore for the night.

28th. Fine day. crew at work overhauling & cleaning up. two carpenters at work putting in bucket hook & two men caulking. finished under fore rigging & worked on stern. watch ashore for the night.

29th. Fine day. Starboard watch ashore for day & evening. John Hughes did not come on board this morning. refused to get in the boat with the rest. drunk & later locked up by police.

30th. Fine day & dry, as usual. crew employed painting & etc. two carpenters & caulkers at work on bow. cooper did some cementing & painting around stern. Hughes came aboard this morning.

Antonio Cabral partly off duty. claps & swelling in groin. May 1st. Another fine day. Caulkers finished work on bow four at work today. crew did a little painting. Mr. Cooper did not come on board this morning. watch on shore for the night. took aboard some game & potatoes.

2nd. Fine weather moderate trades. got all on board & ready for sea. no one on shore tonight.
