Moderate winds from the South and fine
at 9 PM sharp light from the East took in
the Mast. Middle and Latter part the
day Latter part more fine and down
the Old Main sail and bend the corner
on and on sail. Employed in catch-
ing and setting fish this even.

Bar 34.23
Thursday the 27th Moderate winds
and fine. Middle and Latter part
with the same fair & sail. 1st
North this even.

Friday the 28th light winds and fine
under all sail. Latter part the weather
the same. Saw 2 sail & windward Employed
in catching and setting fish this even.

Bar 34.23 Long 162.12W

Saturday the 29th fine winds and fair
weather. From the 1st under all sail. Morning
and Moderate part much the same. Latter
part Moderate with light winds and thick
foggy weather this even this day.

Sunday the 30th baffling winds from the
West and heavy rain. Middle part the
same. Latter part more pleasant the
even.

Monday the 1st commenced with fine winds
from the South and fine weather. At 10
PM took in the Mast. Middle and Latter
part the same. Latter part the
winds from SE and fine this even.

Tuesday the 2nd of Sept 1843

Moderate winds from the SE and fine
weather under all sail. Latter part
Middle part the winds baffling. Latter part
strong winds from East and equally Employed
in sail mending this even. Bar 34.23

Long 159.00W

Wednesday the 3rd fine winds and fine
Middle part headed ESE. Latter part light
squalls of rain. Employed in sail mending
this even. Bar 34.23

Thursday the 4th Moderate winds from
SE and fine. Middle and Latter part
much the same this even.

From 27th and 28th light and
baffling winds. Had fair weather and under
all sail working to the SE and employed
in sail mending this even. Bar 34.23
Long 155.59W

Friday the 5th of October 1843
light and baffling winds from the SE
and fine. Under all sail and Employed
in blacking the iron work. Middle part squalls
and a cold fresh breeze which light sail and
single reefed. Latter part baffling winds and squalls
under all sail this even. Bar 34.23

Saturday the 6th Moderate winds from the SE
and cloudy weather. Headed to the E under
all sail and a swell from the NW.

Middle and Latter part light and
calm. Employed in coopers the Bread
this even.
