Saturday January the 14<sup>th</sup> commences with fresh winds and cloudy and hazy weather to the SE and all sail at 4 P.M. took to the East Middle part much the same at Day light saw the land off the horizon Latter part fair thus ends this day

Sunday the 15<sup>th</sup> had part fresh winds from the East and squally and hazy to the North under all sail - saw some fowls Middle part much the same at 5 P.M. saw a group of land bearing East and North bearing West Dist 15 Latter part fresh winds and fine weather thus ends

Monday the 16<sup>th</sup> commences with fresh East winds and fair weather and steering to the North under all sail Middle and Latter part much the same Employed in mending fowls thus ends

Tuesday the 17<sup>th</sup> had part fresh East winds and fair weather and hazy to the North under all sail Middle and Latter part much the same Employed in setting up the rigging job Room rigging and breaking out for Water thus ends this day

Wednesday the 18<sup>th</sup> commences with moderate Easterly winds and pleasant weather and hazy to the North under all sail saw some fowls and Kiffers - Middle and Latter part much the same thus ends this day

Thursday the 19<sup>th</sup> had part fresh winds from the SE and hazy rainy weather and working to the Eastward under all sail and employed in washing ship at 6 P.M. set the jib and maintail - hove a nother jib and set back out for a nother - maintail Middle part cloudy at 4 P.M. called all hands and bent the main sail with thick Rainy weather thus ends this day

Friday the 20<sup>th</sup> had part baffling winds and squally weather and steering to the Eastward Middle part winds SE and fine weather - Latter part the same under all sail and employed in repairing the mainsail and breaking out for broad BE thus ends this day 24 hours East 11 1/2

Saturday the 21<sup>st</sup> commences with moderate winds from the SE and fair weather and hazy to the East under all sail - at 5 P.M. sent down the mainsail and sent up the old one and bent it at 6 o'clock and Rainy took in the light sails at 8 P.M. used pleasant set the light sails - Middle and Latter part fine employed in repairing and bending the old jib and other jobs thus ends this day

Sunday the 22<sup>nd</sup> had part light air and calm Middle part light winds and fair - Latter part light winds and hazy at 10 P.M. saw a number of fowls thus ends this day - Latter part fine

Monday the 23<sup>rd</sup> commences with light winds from the E and W and steering to the East under all sail at 6 P.M. the wind West and Rainy Middle part fine and winds of W and light Latter part winds of W and employed in breaking set for sails and bending them and repairing the old ones thus ends this day 24 hours - Latter in 11 miles

Tuesday the 24<sup>th</sup> commences with fresh winds from the North and fine weather and steering to the East under all sail - at 6 P.M. saw fowls Middle part much the same Latter part moderate winds and Rainy weather and employed in getting out water and other duty thus ends this day
