

Remarks on Board *Bergue Lexington*

Monday February the 15th commences with moderate winds from the East and fine weather. Fine breeze work in the *Holles* and run in with the *Barre* at 5 P.M. some of the *Canoes* came off at *Shore* at 7 took the *Ship* off *Starboard* and run out with 1200 lbs sperm oil. Middle and Latter part fine and the *all* *Barre* and *choir* in sight and employed in the *Rigging* thus ends this day.

Tuesday the 16th commences with light winds and cloudy weather and sail in sight at 7 P.M. *Shorten* sail *Steering* ESE Middle part fine Latter part the same and all hands employed in fitting *Rigging* *Turning* down &c thus ends

Wednesday the 17th fine weather and light ESE winds and all hands employed in the *Rigging* at 8 saw *Hooper's* *Whale* to the *South* made sail and run down did at 10 *huffed* the wind headed ESE then

Thursday the 18th fine part moderate winds from the North and Cloudy at 7 *Shorten* sail *Hoover* ESE Middle part the same at 9 took to the *ex* under all sail and fine weather thus ends this day.

Friday the 19th commences with moderate winds from the NE and fine weather at 1 P.M. saw a *Shoe* of sperm whales lowered and struck 2 and and *Lawrence* one small one and cut the line from the other by accident bore in the *Small* one. Middle Latter part light air and fine weather at 11 took saw *Black* fish lowered the *Boats* and chased but no purpose - all hands employed in the *Rigging* thus ends this 24 hours ESE

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Saturday the 20th fine part light air and fine weather Middle part the same under all sail Latter part Cloudy saw some *Porpoise* - all hands employed in *hilling* and the *whole* and getting it *Rigging* thus ends this day.

Sunday the 21st fine part light air and Cloudy weather and under all sail - Middle part the *whole* from the North and fine weather headed NE under all sail - Latter part *standing* to the SE at 10 took saw *Ship* *Channel* bearing N by E and 15 miles employed in sail *Mending* thus ends

Monday the 22nd commences with light winds from the North and fine weather at 9 P.M. took to the East at sunset the *Barre* *hoist* and Middle part fresh winds and Cloudy weather Latter part moderate winds and fair and employed in various jobs thus ends

Tuesday the 24th commences with moderate winds from the North and squally weather Middle part fresh winds and Cloudy Latter part strong winds and squally and under *Short* sail thus ends this day.

Wednesday the 25th fine part fresh winds from the North and thick squally weather and under *Short* sail at 6 P.M. took to the *ex* at 7 took in the *Short* *Sp* sail *job* and *Spanker* - Middle part moderate and cloudy - Latter part the same

Thursday and Friday *Solitary* winds and squally weather nothing in sight and not much doing in the time. Some think very unadvisable for us to go and deem it to think the *Whales* will stop *headlines* of every man on deck issued at work from then till then and now too.
