

Remarks On Board Sunday July the 7th 1861
all the day 24 hours fine pleasant weather & calm
gaming with the Ocean spoke the Bark & being Dog
34 months out 6.30 2p

Monday July the 8th light airs from
the west steering on different tack 5 sails in sight
Lat 41° 26' North Long 31° 38' West

Tuesday July the 9th first part
light breezes from the west steering on different tack

Wednesday July the 10th fine weather
and light airs from the N spoke the Bark Gray left
cap Fisher 700 sp

Thursday July the 11th light
light breezes from the N working to the N spoke the
ship Hector

Friday July the 12th all the
24 hours calm weather fine a number of sails in sight

Saturday July the 13th
Fine weather light airs from the N spoke the ship
Swallow of N.B. 2 1/2 months out clean and seen whales
3 times Lat 43° 20' N Long 34° 50' West

Sunday July the 14th
light breezes from the N spoke the ship Benj. Put

Monday July the 15th
light breezes from the W working to the E.N.E.,
seven sails in sight

Tuesday July the 16th
this day begin with fine breezes from the N.E.W.
steering to E.N.E. at night shortened sails latter under
all sail Lat 44° 38' N Long 35° 09' W

Wednesday July the 17th
fine breezes from the W steering & by N spoke the
Anna D. Vory of Boston Lat 45° 08' N Long 34° 04' W

Thursday July the 18th
strong breezes from the W steering & by N middle
steering & by S under short sail latter strong breezes
and squally weather steering & by E Lat 45° 39' N
Long 30° 50' W

Remarks On Board Friday July the 19th 1861
first part strong winds from N.W. steering & by S & by
E under all sail at night shortened sail and came
to the wind heading W by S W latter saw blackfish
lowered with out success Lat 45° 07' N Long 28° 41' W

Saturday July the 20th
this day begins with strong winds from S.W. steering
& by E at night took in sail and luffed to the wind
picked up a barrel of speckled turbot Lat 44° 55' N
Long 29° 32' W

Sunday July 21st
first part strong breeze from N.W. heading
W by S W under double reefed topsails middle the
same latter the wind W by N heading S W

Monday July 22nd
strong winds from W by S W heading S W under
short sail at night wore ship & latter strong
winds from N.W. heading W by S W Lat 43° 49' N
Long 28° 41' W

Tuesday July 23rd
this day begins with strong winds from W by N
heading S W saw two sails at night ~~the~~
wore ship to the N.W. middle & latter moderated
gales from west S W heading S W under short sail
do ends this day Lat 43° 46' N Long 29° 15' W

Wednesday July 24th
Strong Winds from W. S. W heading N. W.
under short sail middle strong gales attended with
rain at 12 M called all hands & closed reefed the main
topsail and furlled the foresail latter wore ship to
the S. W. do ends

Thursday July 25th
This day begins with strong gales from S.W.
to N.W. heading to the W. S. W. middle more
moderate latter fine under all sail
