steering S.E. by S so ends this day

Saturday Nov 16th this day begins with
light airs from the North steering to the S.E. at
day light made the Isle of Delos 10 miles distant
at 3 P.m. came to Anchor in 5 fathom of water

Sunday Nov 17th at Anchor fine weather
Starboard watch on liberty so ends this day

Monday Nov 18th at anchor all hands
employed in getting off wood & water

Tuesday Nov 19th the Starboard watch on
Liberty the Starboard watch getting of wood
and water so ends this day

Wednesday Nov 20th Starboard watch on
Liberty so ends this day

Thursday Nov 21th the Starboard watch
on Liberty the Starboard watch on board getting
ready for sea

Friday Nov 22th light breezes from
S.E. at 6 am took our anchor & went to sea
better light airs from S.W. steering to
the westward by the wind

Remarks On Board Saturday Nov 23rd
all the day 24 hours light airs from S.E. steering
S.W. employed in pounding rust of the cable

Sunday Nov 24th first part light airs
from the E steering S.W. by S latter part winds
from all parts of the compass attending with
rain thunder & lightning

Monday Nov 25th airs from all parts
employed in picking the cable

Tuesday Nov 26th airs from all parts
employed in picking the cable so ends
lowered for blackfish without success to sails
in sight

Wednesday Nov 27th light breezes from
S.E. steering S.W. by S employed in setting up
rigging

Thursday Nov 28th fine breezes from the
South steering W. S.W. by the wind so ends

Friday Nov 29th strong breezes from the S
steering to the westward by the wind

Saturday Nov 30 begins with fine breezes
from the S.E. heading S.W. under all
sail so ends this day

Sunday Dec 1st
Monday Nov 31st begins with fine
weather & light wind from S.E. heading
S.W. under all sail
Lat 00. 42 N
Long 21. 23 West

Monday Dec 2nd strong breezes from
S.E. steering S.W. by S employed in painting
the boats under all sail
Lat 1. 05 South
Long 23. 45 West
