raised Sperm Whales at 2 pm lowerd the boat
the waist Boat darted both irons against a
whale but did not get fast at night came
on board middle S latter squally Lat 20. 20 S
Long 35. 55 W

Sunday Dec 15th strong breezes from the
N steering I rain & squales under easy sail
son ends this day Lat 21. 36 South
Long 35. 18 W

Monday Dec 16th fine weather & strong
breezes from Southward steering S by E latter
part the same Lat 24. 10 South
Long 35. 40 West

Tuesday Dec 17th fine weather & strong
breezes from S.E. steering under easy sail
on the wind latter part standing boat crews
watching with a moderate gail hove too under easy
sail Lat " South
Long " West

working to the Southward under easy sail rainy
