Tuesday Dec 24th fine breezes from E steering
on diff tacks 4 sails in sight the Falcon &
Cornelia of New Bedford the Bark Snawan of New
port & Brigg Susan of Sag Harbor No Obs

Wednesday Dec 25th strong breezes from the E
at 1 pm raised whales in C. with the above men
ships & lowered the Starboard boat got 2 and the
waist got 1 at 9 pm got them along side all the
other ships got whales at daylight commenced cutting
strong breezes from N.W.



Thursday Dec the 26th strong breezes
from N.W. finished boiling & commenced
cutting in so ends this day

Friday Dec 27th strong breezes from N.W.
boiling spoke the Brigg Susan of Sag Harbor 7
months out 25 SP under easy sail by the

Saturday Dec 28th fine weather & light breeze
from N.W. at 5 pm finished boiling two sails in sight

Sunday Dec 29th all these 24 hours fine breeze
from N steering on diff tacks so ends

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Remarks On Board Monday Dec 30th
fine weather & light wind from N.W. steering on
diff tacks under easy sail latter part employed
in stowing down four sails in sight

Tuesday Dec 31st begins with light airs from N.E.
calm at 2 pm spoke the Bark Cornelia at 6 pm
finished stowing down 37 lbs latter part fresh winds from
N to N.E. with rain squally working to the N.W. 2 sails in sight

Wednesday Jan the 1st begins with light winds from
N to E with rain squalls working to the N.W. westward
latter part strong breezes from N.W. fine weather gamed
with the Barks Falcon & Cornelia of N. Bedford
Lat 24.24 Long 37.30

Thursday Jan 2nd first part fine weather
and strong breeze from N.E. on the wind under
sail latter part weather thick & hazy 2 sails in sight

Friday
Wednesday Jan 3rd strong breezes from S.E.
weather thick hazy middle part moderate gales
with rain latter part more moderate with rain
squally lying under easy sail three sails in sight

Saturday Jan 4th moderate gale from N.E.
with rain squally weather thick & hazy so ends
this day

Sunday Jan 5th first part strong winds from
N.W. & hazy middle part more moderate one sail
in sight heading N.W. under easy sail under the
sail

Monday Jan 6th fine weather & strong winds
from N.W. on different tacks by the wind latter
part moderate gales under easy sail

Tuesday Jan 7th begins with moderate gales from
N.W. middle the same latter winds from N.W.
steering N by W
