Remarks On Board Wednesday Jan the 8th
first part strong breezes from N.W. steering N by E
on the wind one sail in sight latter part fine work
to the N.W. Lat 23° 00' Long 37° 10'

Thursday Jan the 9th this day begins with fine
weather & light winds from S.W. spoke the Briggs & Bath
Post of New York Middle & latter moderate breezes from
S.W. repaired the fore sail

Friday Jan 10th first part light breezes from S
heading W. S.W. middle & latter the same under short
sail so ends this day

Saturday Jan 11th all the day 24 hours strong breeze
from E.S.E. steering to the S.W. in 6 P.M. with the Bar
Chili of New Bedford

Sunday Jan 12th begins with fine weather & light
breezes steering to the Southwest in 6 P.M. with the Chili
middle & latter the same at 8 P.M. raised whales the
Chili boats struck first lowered all three boats the
Starboard Boat got one at 10 A.M. gave up chasing &
came on board & commenced cutting

Monday Jan 13th begins with strong breezes from E
employed in cutting at 3 P.M. finished middle &
latter more moderate & rain the Chili in sight

Tuesday Jan 14th this day begins with the light wind
from the E employed in cutting up blubber & punks
latter part strong breezes boiling the Chili in sight

Wednesday Jan 15th begins with moderate gale
from the westward at dark cooled down at day light
started the works again

Thursday Jan 16th strong winds from the west &
heavy sea running at 4 P.M. finished boiling middle
& latter strong winds from S.W. with Rain

Friday Jan 17th strong breezes from S.W. & rainy
middle & latter light breezes from N. steering
employed in stowing down oil

Remarks On board Saturday Jan the 18th
these 24 hours moderate breezes from N. to N.E. steering
to the S.W. the weather thick & rainy attended with thunder
& lightning

Sunday Jan 19th strong breezes from the N.
steering to the S.W. under short sail

Monday Jan 20th first part moderate breezes
from S.E. steering W. by S middle part heading
to the N.W. by the wind latter steering W. S.W.
Lat 28° 30' S
Long 42° 40' W

Tuesday Jan 21st begins with strong breezes from
N. steering to the W. latter part strong breezes from
the S steering W. by S one sail in sight

Wednesday Jan 22nd moderate breezes from S.W.
eastward steering to the S. & westward on the wind
one sail in sight latter part light air from the
S.E. steering to the south & westward caught three
turtles and repaired the fore sail

Thursday Jan 23rd begins with fine weather & light
airs from the S.W. westward on the wind finished the
fore sail & bent it latter part strong breezes from
the E steering to the S.E. eastward one sail in sight

Friday Jan 24 begins with strong wind from east
crusing on the wind at 4 P.M. game with the ship
Beng Tucker of New Bedford 8 1/2 months out with 300 Sp
Lat 29° 57' South
Long 44° 31' West

Saturday Jan 25th strong breeze from the eastward
crusing on the wind saw several merchantmen latter
part the same so ends this day

Sunday Jan 26th strong breezes from
the eastward weather thick & rainy crusing on
the wind under double reefed topsails
latter part strong breezes from S.E.
