

Remarks On board Friday Feb 14th 1869
begins with fine weather & strong breezes from
E. & steering to the south & westward latter part
the same gamed with the Light Northan Light
four out from New Bedford Clear

Saturday Feb 15th fine weather & strong breeze
from the E. & gaming with the Northan Light
at 4 Pm raised whales, lowered all the boats, our Co
lowered from the other ship at 6 Pm Capt. Grinnell
struck at 7 Pm took the whale along side of the
S. Light. Both ships laying in Co. all night at
day light commenced cutting in our mate aboard
the ship & Capt. Taber aboard of us looking for more
Lat 30° 43' S
Long 44° 37' W

Sunday Feb 16th fine weather moderate breezes
from the eastward at 1 Pm finished cutting &
at dark Capt. Taber went on board & our mate
came on board of us latter fine gamed with the
Bark Seene of New Bedford 38 months out 3048
Pound home

Monday Feb 17th fine weather & moderate breeze
from N. N. E. cruising on the wind latter part
the same working to the S. & westward in Co. with
Northan Light she Boiling the whale

Tuesday Feb 18th fine weather & moderate breeze
from the E. N. E. gamed with the S. Light latter
part fine weather at 8 Am took our share of oil &
then steered to S. & westward in Co.

Wednesday Feb 19th fine weather & light wind
from the S. S. W. gamed with the S. Light latter
part light breezes from the S. S. E. with heavy swell
on 2 sails in sight the Northan Light & Chili

Thursday Feb 20th strong breezes from the
S. S. E. steering on the wind latter part the
same 3 sails in sight

Remarks On Board Feb Friday 27th
This day begins with strong breezes from
the S. E. steering to the S. W. through the day
latter part fine weather

Saturday Feb 22nd Moderate gales from
E. S. E. with rain lying two under easy sail
latter part strong breezes from S. W. heading
S. S. E. by the wind

Sunday Feb 23rd Strong gales from E. & E
lying two under easy sail a Bagg in sight
latter part more moderate made sail a heavy
swell on

Monday Feb 24th strong breeze from S. E
steering to the S. W. under easy sail so
ends this day

Tuesday Feb 25th

Wednesday Feb 26th Strong breezes from the S. E
weather thick & hazy at 4 Pm finished stowing
down 20 bbls of gamed with the Benj. Tucker &
Northan Light latter part strong breezes from
S. E. with rain

Thursday Feb 27th wind from all quarters
with rain latter part wind from E. N. E. with
fine weather 1 sail in sight

Friday Feb 28th fine weather & light wind
from the Southward & calm gamed with the S. Light
latter part fine weather & light wind from S. E.
steering to the N. E. in Co. with the S. Light

Saturday March 1st begins with fine weather
& light winds from the westward steering to the
N. E. Eastward in Co. with the S. Light
To Ends this day
