fine weather & moderate breezes from W by S
steering E by S for the Coast of Africa commenced
to land & off watches finished the Boat &
put her on the cranes latter part fine
weather wind from the S steering E by S
under all sail

Wednesday March 19th weather light winds from
the S steering E by S under all sail one sail in
sight middle & latter light winds from the S
with rain squalls

Thursday 20th light winds from the E
fine weather Spike the Ship Robert Edwards of
New Bedford 52 months out 2000 bbls home
latter part the same with rain & squalls

Friday 21st light airs & calm with rain & squalls
middle and latter part strong breezes from W by S
heading to the eastward

Saturday 22nd, fine weather & calm middle
& latter part moderate breezes from W by S
fine weather steering E by S one sail in sight
So ends this day

Sunday 23rd fine weather & light airs from
the N.W. steering to the E latter part the
same so ends this day Lat 30° 30' South
Long 35° 20' West

Monday March 24th fine weather & light
breezes from S.E. steering to the E latter
part the same so ends this day

Tuesday March 25th Strong breezes from
the S & Westward with rain & squalls steering
E by S South under all sail middle & latter
the same

Wednesday March 26th Strong breezes from
the S.W. & S squally steering E by S under all
sail latter part more moderate steering East

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Remarks On Board March 27th Thursday
fine weather & moderate breezes from the
S.W. middle & latter part wind from
S.E. with rain heading to the E

Friday March 28th moderate breezes
from S.W. steering E by S under all sail
latter part the same

Saturday March 29th fine weather &
moderate breezes from W by S steering
E by S employed in rigging out Studing sails
middle & latter the same Lat 30° 15' South
Long 21° 27' West

Sunday March 30th begins with fine
weather & light winds from westward
steering E by S under all sail Lat 28° 37' South
Long 18° 37' West

Monday March 31st fine weather & moderate
breezes from the west steering E by S under
all sail latter part the same so ends
this day & month

April
Tuesday March 1st fine weather & light
breezes from the west ward steering E by S
bent the royals and sent them aloft
latter part wind North

Wednesday April 2nd this day begins
with moderate breezes from N.E. steering
E by S latter strong breezes from N.W.
Lat 29° 34' South
Long 10° 54' West

Thursday April 3rd Strong breezes from
the N.W. with thunder & lightning steering
E by S latter part strong breezes from
S.W. under topsails & courses Lat 29° 37' South
Long 7° 00' West

Friday April 4th Strong breezes from
the S steering E by S latter part more moderate
under all sail
