breezes from S.W. steering W. by N. & employing
in painting boats in sides
Lat 15 " 04 South
Long 9 " 49 East

Tuesday April 29th first part fine breezes
from W. S. W. steering W. by N. & middle &
latter the same employed in painting the
boats out side
Lat 15 " 13 South
Long 7 " 45 East

Wednesday April 30th first & middle part
fine breezes from S. S. W. steering W. by N. latter
part calm finished painting the boats
Lat 15 " 11 South
Long 6 " 16 East

Thursday May 1st begins with light
winds & light breezes from S. steering
W. by N. under all sail so ends this day

Friday May 2nd fine weather & light
breezes from S. steering W. by N. latter part
fine weather at 11 P.M. raised 3 sperm whales
going N. by W. at 12 lowered the boats
Lat 16 " 00 South
Long 2 " 30 East

Remarks On Board Saturday May 3rd 1862
fine breezes from S. boats after the whales
at 3 P.M. the Starboard Boat struck & got
stove at 4.30 P.M. took the whale along side &
got up the cutting gear & at daybreak
commenced cutting in

Sunday May 4th fine weather & light breezes
from E. employed in cutting so ends
this day

Monday May 5th this day begins with
fine weather & light breezes from S. steering
W. finished cutting & boiled the case &
started the work latter part boiling

Tuesday May 6th this day begins with
fine weather & light winds steering W.
employed in boiling

Wednesday May 7th fine weather & light
breezes from S. steering W. employed
in boiling so ends this day

Thursday May 8th all these 24 hours fine
weather & light breezes from S. steering
W. by N. for S. Helenz finished
boiling turned up 103 bbls

Friday May 9th fine weather & light
breezes from S. steering W. by N. at 4 P.M.
made the land came too off the town the
Capt. & boats crew ashore for letters

Saturday May 10th fine weather lying
of S. at 6 P.M. the Capt. came off &
stayed to the S. on the wind middle
& latter on diff tacks by the wind
