

Remarks On Board Saturday July 17th
 This day begins with moderate gales
 from NW heading S. W. under
 sail

Sunday July 18th first part moderate
 from NW heading to the S. W. under
 sail middle part the same latter part
 fine weather and light winds from E. steering
 NW too sails in sight Lat 41 " 27 N
 Long 35 " 46 W

Monday July 19th this day begins with
 light breeze from E steering NW middle
 & latter the same lowered for blackfish
 without success at 11 1/2 PM raised sperm whale
 Lat 41 " 07 N
 Long 36 " 32 W

Tuesday July 20th this day begins with
 fine weather & fresh breeze from West sperm
 whales in sight at 7 PM lowered the Boat
 at 2 1/2 the Boat struck at 3 1/2 took him
 along side & rove the cutting gear under
 the latter strong wind from NW with heavy
 swell on bying by the whale waiting for
 the swell to go down

Wednesday July 21st begins with strong
 winds from NW with a heavy swell on
 at 10 commenced cutting at night lashed down
 the pul for the night at day light commenced
 cutting again at noon finished the body of
 whaler 3 sails in sight Lat 40 " 39 N
 Long 35 " 57 W

Thursday July 22nd fine weather commenced cutting
 the head at 5 PM finished baiting the case
 & started the work middle & latter light
 winds from NW heading to the N. Boiling

Friday July 23rd begins with moderate
 gales from NW heading to the N. by the
 wind boiling middle & latter the same
 Lat 40 " 13 N
 Long 36 " 37 W

 middle & latter strong breezes from NW
 heading NW Lat 41 " 48 N

Sunday July 20th Strong winds from

 spoke the Bark Gipsy 2 months out clean
 the Ship Contest 14 months too whale & 200 sp
 Lat " " N

Monday July 21st begins with strong
 winds from NW steering on diff. tacks by
 the wind latter part more moderate
 employed in stowing down oil

Tuesday July 22nd this day begins with
 fresh winds from NW steering to the SE
 under easy sail finished stowing down

Wednesday July 23rd Strong winds from
 NW steering SE under double reefed top sail
 middle & latter the same

Thursday July 24th moderate winds from
 NW heading SE middle the same latter
 wind from NW steering SE by 4 spoke
 French Bark Lat 39 " 40 N
 Long 34 " 23 W

Friday July 25th Light winds from NW
 steering SE by 4 for the 2-36 ground latter
 wind to the NW steering on the wind
 so ends this day
