 this day begins with moderate gales from N.E. to E. spoke the Bark Sarah Mattaponi
 14 months out 300 9 pm reported no whales on the ground latter part more moderate steering on
 the wind the Island of Flores

Monday July 28th fine weather & strong wind
 from E spoke the Brig Falcon of Salem
 2 months out 110 9 pm latter part wind from
 the S.E. steering by the wind

Tuesday July 29th fine weather & strong
 winds from the S.E. steering by the
 wind latter part wind from S.E.

Lat 39 " 53 N
 Long 33 " 49 W

Wednesday July 30th fine weather & moderate
 breeze from S.E. steering on the wind to the
 N.E. mended the fore sail & bent it latter part
 the same

Lat " " North
 Long " " West

Thursday July 31st begins with strong
 breeze from S.W. at 5 pm made the Isles
 of Carriacou & Floride at 6 " came too off the
 N.E. end of Floride Capt. S. boat's crew on
 shore at dark came off & stood off shore for
 the night latter part spoke the Bark Tropicbird
 9 months out 15 lbs 9 pm

Friday Aug 1st fine weather & strong
 winds from N.E. & W. lying off and on
 recruits latter part the same

Saturday Aug 2nd strong winds from
 N.E. lying off & on getting recruits spoke
 the Bark M. S. Bartow of Nantucket 3 months
 out

Sunday Aug 3rd fine weather & light
 winds from the E employed in getting
 water & recruits latter part strong winds
 from W. with S. W. nothing doing on board
 one boat crew

Remarks On Board Monday Aug the 4th 1862
 this day begins with fine weather & light
 winds from E. & S. lying off getting
 wood & water & recruits

Tuesday Aug 5th begins with fine weather
 & light winds from E. & S. finished recruiting
 latter part wind from S.W. took our leave
 of Floride steering on the wind to the
 westward saw too sail

Wednesday Aug 6th fine weather & moderate
 breezes from the S.E. steering on the wind
 to the westward curiously employed latter part
 the same

Thursday Aug 7th fine weather & light winds
 from the S.W. steering on the wind to the W. saw
 several sails of merchantmen, middle &
 latter part strong winds with rain squalls
 thunder & lightning, boarded a Scotch ship
 bound to the West Indies

Friday
 Wednesday Aug 8th strong breezes from
 the S.W. steering on the wind with rain
 to the W. too sails in sight one of them
 steering to the eastward latter moderate breezes
 from the W. cruising on the wind

Lat 42 " 21 North
 Long 36 " 29 West

Saturday Aug 9th begins with fine weather
 & light breezes from the W. steering on the wind
 latter part strong breezes from S.W. with
 rain squalls steering by the wind to the W.

Sunday Aug 10th strong winds from
 the W. with thick & hazy steering on
 the wind to the W. latter strong wind
 with heavy swell & raining lying too under
 short sail two sails in sight
