Remarks On Board Monday Aug 25th
This day begins with fine weather & light winds
from the W. & W. S. W. gamed with the Ocean latter
part light winds from the W. at 6 Am raised
Sp Whales matted with the Ocean, all 6 boats in
chase so ends this day

Tuesday Aug 26th Strong wind from
the W. with fog & rain at 2 Pm the Ocean
boat struck at 4 Pm took him along side of the
Ocean & commenced cutting at dark harked the fire
down for the night

Long 36 .. 26 West

Wednesday Aug 27th Strong winds from W. W. S. W.
cruising on the wind at 6 Am our mate & Boat
crew on board the Ocean helping cut at 4 Pm took
the Head along side the Tucker at 11 Pm had it
all on board latter part commenced Peeling in
C. with the Ocean

Thursday Aug 28th fine weather cruising on
the wind boiling still in C. at 4 Pm the Ocean
picked up a dead Whale



Friday Aug 29th light winds from the W. W. S. W.
with rain squalls finished boiling 30 bbls head
latter part Strong winds from the E. & S. E. gamed
with the Bark O. Leola 3rd of New Bedford 30 m
out 15 bbls Sp

Saturday Aug 30th fine weather & light winds
from the E. Spok the Ocean & divided our oil
about 45 bbls apiece latter part with the same

Sunday Aug 31st fine weather & moderate
winds from the E. latter the same saw the Ocean
take a whale at 6 am raised more lowed in C. with
the Drigg. Falcon of Salem on the Starboard bow
darted at the whale but did not get fast at 9 came
on board whale going to windward

Remarks On Board Monday Sept 7th 1862
This day begins with fine weather & light winds
from the E. gamed with the Breeze Falcon 3rd
out with 115 bbls Sp latter part the same cruising
on the wind

Lat 35 .. 52 North
Long 37 .. 14 West

Tuesday Sept 2nd fine weather & moderate breeze
from the E. & S. E. cruising on the wind latter part
Strong winds working to the W. S. W.

Wednesday Sept 3rd Moderate breezes from the
E. & S. E. cruising on the wind saw 4 Sails latter
the same employed in stowing down

Thursday Sept 4th Moderate breezes from the
E. & S. E. with rain squalls at 6 Pm finished
stowing down about 50 bbls oil cruising on the
wind

Friday Sept 5th fine weather & moderate
winds from the E. & S. E. cruising on the
wind latter part the same nothing in sight
so ends this day

Saturday Sept 6th Light winds from
S. E. with rain squalls mended the fore
Top sail & bent it latter part light winds
& variables saw several Merchant men
Lat 36 .. 28 North
Long 36 .. 32 West

Sunday Sept 7th Fine weather moderate
breezes cruising on the wind saw several
Sails steering to the N. E. & E.

Monday Sept 8th Strong breezes from
S. E. bying too heading to the S. W. middle
& latter Strong gales

Tuesday Sept 9th Moderate gales from S. E.
& thick weather hove too heading S. W. so ends
this day
