Friday Nov 14<sup>th</sup> begins with light airs from E to S.E. middle & latter light airs from all points two sails in sight merchantmen Lat 6 .. 41 North Long 23 .. 43 West

Saturday Nov 15<sup>th</sup> light airs from E to S.E. middle & latter light airs from all points Lat 6 .. 14 North Long .. .. West

Sunday Nov 16<sup>th</sup> light variable winds from the South & East steering to the S.W. by the wind middle & latter wind S.W. Lat 5 .. 37 North Long 23 .. 53 West

Monday Nov 17<sup>th</sup> all these 24 hours moderate winds from S.W. S.E. steering to the S.W. by the wind Lat 3 .. 49 North Long 25 .. 10 West

Tuesday Nov 18<sup>th</sup> fine breeze from S.W. heading to the S.W. by the wind middle & latter wind from S on diff tacks by the wind Lat 3 .. 02 North Long 25 .. 33 West

Wednesday Nov 19<sup>th</sup> moderate breezes from S heading S.W. middle & latter part light airs from all points of the compass Lat 3 .. 10 North Long 25 .. 55 West

Thursday Nov 20<sup>th</sup> fresh breezes from W.S.W. heading S.W. by the wind under all sail Lat 00 .. 35 North Long 27 .. 48 West

Friday Nov 21<sup>st</sup> fresh winds from S.E. to E & S.E. heading to the S.W. middle & latter the same Lat 1 .. 31 South Long 29 .. 03 West

Saturday Nov 22<sup>nd</sup> This day begins with fresh winds from S.E. heading S.W. two sails in sight middle & latter the same employed in taring down the rigging Lat 4 .. 06 South Long 27 .. 28 West

Remarks On Board Sunday Nov 23<sup>rd</sup> 1862

This day begins with fresh breezes from S.E. heading to the S.W. middle & latter the same Lat 6 .. 23 South Long 30 .. 53 West

Monday Nov 24<sup>th</sup> begins with fresh breezes from S.E. heading to the S.W. middle & latter the same so ends Lat 9 .. 00 South Long 31 .. 42 West

Tuesday Nov 25<sup>th</sup> All these 24 hours strong winds from S.E. steering S.W. by S. Lat 12 .. 59 South Long 32 .. 59 West

Wednesday Nov 26<sup>th</sup> This day begins with fresh winds from S.E. steering S.W. by S under all sail so ends this day Lat 14 .. 39 South Long 34 .. 24 West

Thursday Nov 27<sup>th</sup> fresh breezes from S.E. to E & S.E. steering S.W. by S. took the waist boat on deck nailed & carried her in side Lat 16 .. 29 South Long 36 .. 17 West

Friday Nov 28<sup>th</sup> All these 24 hours moderate wind from E to E.S.E. steering S one sail in sight Lat 18 .. 42 South Long 36 .. 27 West

Saturday Nov 29<sup>th</sup> begins with fine breezes from S.E. steering S.W. by S painting the Leeward boat Lat 20 .. 05 South Long 35 .. 57 West

Sunday Nov 30<sup>th</sup> moderate breezes from S.E. steering to the South nothing in sight so ends this day Lat 23 .. 08 South Long 36 .. 03 West

Dec 1<sup>st</sup> Monday Dec 1<sup>st</sup> first part strong winds from S at 4 P.M. spoke the Schooner "Jehod" of Fairhaven Capt. Benson 16 miles out with 140 Spm middle strong breezes heading E & S.E. latter thick & rainy under short sail heading W.S.W. Lat .. .. South Long .. .. West
