This day begins with strong wind from N. with rain heading W. E. W. under short sail ~~middle~~ ~~the same~~

Wednesday Dec 3rd This day begins with strong breezes from N. with rain steering on different tacks so ends this day

Thursday Dec 4th fresh breezes from the N. thick & rainy with standing on different tacks by the wind under short sail

Friday Dec 5th fresh breezes from N. steering to the W. under short sail middle & latter steering on different tacks, one sail in light

Saturday Dec 6th first part strong breezes from N. W. heading W. E. W. under short sail middle & latter the same

Sunday Dec 7th fine weather & light wind from W. E. W. steering on the wind at 3 P.M. saw a whale two risings to the windward in the San Glade & last sight of him latter light winds from N. E. W. weather thick & rain one sail in light

Monday Dec 8th light winds from S. E. with rain lying under easy sail latter part good weather steering on the wind

Tuesday Dec 9th fine weather & light winds from the E. E. gammed with the Brigg Susan of Sag Harbor 14 m out 75 Spm 130 whale latter part the same

Wednesday Dec 10th fine weather & light wind from the E. E. steering to the W. E. in the evening with the Susan at 3 P.M. rain sperm whales lowered the boats the Starboard boat struck & parted the line struck again & captured him the Must boat struck & captured him at dark took them along side the Starboard boat chasing the whales to leeward in the evening with the Brigg boats at Sun down gave up chasing & came on board the S. boat struck & bent the iron at day light commenced cutting at 9 A.M. finished & made sail

Strong breezes from N. E. with rain middle part strong with rain latter part wind from S. E. with rain lying under short sail

Friday 12th moderate gales from the S. E. turned up the Starboard boat latter part good weather at day light commenced towing gammed with the Bark Eliza of New Bedford 38 m out with 300 Spm & 15 whale & the Bark Elizabeth of Newport 19 m out with 470 Spm

Saturday 13th good weather & moderate winds from S. E. cruising on the wind-boiling latter part the same 10 A.M. finished boiling about 24 bbls of oil

Sunday Dec 14th fine weather moderate breezes from the S. E. gammed with the Elizabeth latter the same under easy sail

Monday Dec 15th good weather & moderate winds from E. E. cruising on the wind employed in stowing down latter gammed with the Brigg Argo of Fayal
