rather part strong breeze with thick & hazy

Saturday Dec 20th, Strong breeze from NW
with thick & hazy at 1^{PM} Spike the Schoon
Roswell King of Fairhaven 19th out 150 Sp at
3^{PM} raised a School of Sperm whales - towed
all three boats with out success at 6^{PM} gave
them up & came on board whales going on
to the wind rd latter part fine weather & light
wind from the SE steering to the N^W & E
in the with 4 other whales Lat 26 " 28³⁰ South
Long 36 " 38 West

Sunday Dec 21st, fine weather & light air from the N^W with calms caught a Dinner fish at 6 Pm. gained the Bark *Marscella* of New Bedford 7 Pm, out 4.50 Pm latter part fine weather & light winds from the N^W & E. wind on the wind so ends this day

Monday Dec 22nd moderate breezes from
the S^W weather thick & hazy latter part
weather squally & a plenty of rain

Tuesday Dec 23rd Strong breeze from N.W.
 177th weather thick & hazy cruising on the
 wing latter part wind from S.W. steering to
 the S.W. End. Lat 25 .. 46 Long 35 .. 48 Dist

Wednesday Dec 24th Moderate winds from
the S.W. with fine weather steering by the wind
to the north, middle & latter the same

Thursday, Dec 25th, fine weather & light
winds from S.W. crossing on the wind
3 miles in sight latter part the same at 5 p.m.
gained with the Brig. Argo she had clear
shots all the forenoon but with out success what
going quick to Eastward, Lat 26 " 23 South
Long 36 " 18 West

Wednesday, Friday Dec 24th fine weather
slight wind from SE, cruising "one the wind"
at 10 pm gale with the frog & cork
Marshall's latter light moderate breeze from NW
during Dec 24th

this day begins with fine wth a moderate
wind from the steering S^W by S latter part
wind from S^W heading on the wind

Sunday Dec 28th fine weather & light winds from the NW at 3 pm rais sperm whales in Co. with the Bark Oye both ships lowered there boats but with out success whales going quick to the NW latter part fine wth & light wind from SW steering by the wind

Monday Dec 29th good weather & under a King
from 10⁰⁰ steering to the N. E. 3rd in 60 min. with
the tide & 4 Pm gained with her latter wind
from the N. E. steering S. W. with a thick & hazy

Tuesday Dec 30th moderate breezes from N^W
with rain steering on the wind to the West
latter wind from N^W to steering I good weather
& nothing to do plenty help Lat 38 " 20 South
Long 40 " 25 West

Wednesday Dec 31st A good weather moderate
winds from NW & steering W by S at 5 pm
discovered a wreck bottom up went to it
but got nothing but a piece of lead & a steel &
copper lathe the same steering South so on
this day North & year Lat 28 .. 40 Long
43 .. 03 West

Thursday June 7th this year & day begins

rather thick & hazy steering S.W. by S. latter
