Wednesday Jan 21st good weather & strong
winds from S.W. Cruising on the wind
at 2 P.M. gained with the bark "Purvey" of New
Bedford 45 mi out 2000 spm & 800 yds
Lat 46 " 16 South
Long 57 " 03 West

Thursday Jan 22nd strong winds from
the S.W. Cruising on the wind 3 sails in sight
middle part moderate gales from S.W. latter
part moderate with Rain squalls

Friday Jan 23rd good weather & strong
breezes from the S.W. steering S.W. middle
part strong gales from W. to S.W. with
heavy squalls lying too under short sail
Lat 45 " 53 South
Long 56 " 16 West

Saturday Jan 24th still blowing from
the S.W. lying too under closed reefed
main top sail & fore topmast staysail
middle & latter the same

Sunday Jan 25th still blowing from
the S.W. with a heavy sea on & squally
latter part more moderate steering to the
S.W. on the wind Lat 45 " 42 South
Long 56 " 27 West

Monday Jan 26th moderate breezes from
S.W. with Rain & fog steering S.W. by
the wind middle & latter the same
ends this day Lat 46 " 31 South
Long 56 " 27 West

S.W. middle & latter lying too under short
sail so ends this day

Wednesday Jan 28th Strong winds from
S.W. Cruising on the wind under double
reefed topsails saw the ship Contest & Bark
Calio of New Bedford Lat 46 " 10 South
Long 56 " 52 West

Thursday Jan 29th Cruising on the wind
in C. with the Contest latter gained & got
some wood

Friday Jan 30th moderate gales from S.W.
lying too on the harbor tack 2 sails in
sight so ends Lat 46 " 13 South
Long 56 " 34 West

Saturday Jan 31st good weather & strong
winds from West 3d gained with the Calio
and got some wood

Sunday Feb 1st good weather & light
winds from the S.W. middle & latter
part light Air & Calm

Monday Feb 2nd Strong winds from
the S.W. at 1 P.M. gained with the bark
Pacific & the Bedford 3 mi out 85 spm
latter part gained with the Contest & James
Arnold, & got some wood of the Pacific

Tuesday Feb the 3rd Strong breezes from
the S.W. Cruising on the wind under double
reefed topsails & sails in sight whalers latter part
good weather & moderate winds from S.W. standing
to the S.W. on the wind Lat 45 " 47 South
Long 46 " 00 West

Wednesday Feb 4th good weather moderate
winds from S.W. Cruising on the wind latter
part wind from West good weather Cruising
on the wind

Thursday Feb 5th good weather & strong breezes from S.W.
standing to the S.W. standing on the wind in C. with the
Contest & James Arnold latter part wind from the S.W. &
rugged Lat 46 " 22 Long 56 " 37 W
