Remarks On Board Saturday Feb 21st
good wether moderate breeze from N.E. cruising
on the wind at 4 Pm Gained with the Chile
again latter part wind from N.W. wether thick
& hazy saw two Merchantmen, latter fine wether
light winds S.W. steering N.E. in Co. with
the said Bark

Sunday Feb 22nd fine wether & light winds
from S.W. steering to the N.E. in Co. with
the said Bark latter part the same

Monday Feb 23rd Moderate Breezes from the
S.W. at 10 Am gained with the Bark Pacific
45 miles out 1000 lbs of our skate & skins
left & went on board of her to get home latter
part wether the same steering N.E. at
3 Am raised sperm whales run in to them
with the ship about day light & gallied them
at 8 am lowered all three boats in chase in Co.
with the Bark Symmeria but with out success
at 11 Am gave them up came on board
the whales going much to the windward the
Chile in sight to the windward

Tuesday Feb 24th good wether & moderate
breezes from the S.E. cruising on the wind
in Co. with the Symmeria at 1 Pm raised
a school off our Sea Beam 2 miles off & killed
with the said Bark lowered all 6 boats our ship
lost struck & captured him at 3 Pm took him
along side at 4 commenced cutting at & finished
latter part wether the same at 9 Am com. boiling
cruising on the wind in Co. with the said Bark

Wednesday Feb 25th strong winds from the S.E.
steering on the wind in Co. with said Bark &
boiling latter part the same

Thursday Feb 26th good wether & moderate breeze
from the S.E. steering on the wind finished
boiling latter part wether the same gave the Symmeria
her share of the whale 11 lbs & got some wood

Friday Feb 27th
good wether & moderate breezes from S.E. cruising
on the wind to the N.E. & S.W. latter part fine wether
light wind from the E. steering on the wind to
the S.W.

one sail in sight whaler man latter part wind
from N.E. cruising on the wind gained with
the Bark Little of Fair Haven 2 months out 800 lbs
& the Brigg Pavilion of St Haven 2 months out 350 lbs

Sunday March 1st fine wether & moderate
winds from the N.E. cruising on the wind 4 miles
in sight whaler man latter part the same

Monday Mar 2nd fine wether & moderate
winds from N.E. cruising on the wind 6
miles in sight all whalers latter part the same

Tuesday Mar 3rd good wether & moderate
winds from the N.E. steering on the wind
gained with the Bark Marcella of New Bedford
200 lbs latter part variable thunder lightning
& rain

Wednesday Mar 4th good wether moderate wind
from west gained with the Bark Milwood of
N.B. 9 months out 210 lbs latter part fine wether
wind from the S.W. & sail in sight

Thursday March 5th this day begins with
fine wether & light winds from the S.E.
cruising on the wind latter part the same

Friday Mar 6th good wether wether moderate
wind from the S.E. gained with the Symmeria
latter wind the same steering to the south on the wind
in Co. with said Bark
