Remarks On Board Saturday March 7th
fine wether moderate winds from the E & S
steering south at 3 PM raised sperm whale
at 5 took all three ~~boats~~ the first boat stove
& captured him at 7 took him along side
by him all night at day light commenced
cutting with the same



Sunday Mar 8th good wether strong wind
from the E & S commenced cutting at sundown
got his body in lay by his head all night
at day light com on his head took in his
junk & W & M finished hauling his case &
started the work latter part fine wether
light air & calm

Monday Mar 9th fine wether & light
winds from the E & S & calm steering to the
S on the wind latter part wind from S
& fine wether employed in boiling
Lat 31° 29' S
Long 45° 55' W

Tuesday Mar 10th good wether wind from S
steering on the wind to the S & S still boiling
latter part wind from the S & S fine wether
heading to the E & S still boiling

Wednesday Mar 11th strong wind from S & S
at 6 AM finished boiling turned up about 9
20 bbls latter part wether the same heading to the
E & S on the wind

Thursday 12th moderate gales from the W & W
have two on the starboard tack one sail in sight
middle part part blowing heavy from W & W
blowed up the main top sail latter part more
moderate heading on the wind to the S & S
Lat 30° 38' South
Long 44° 02' West

Friday Mar 13th strong breezes from the W & W
cruising on the wind to the S & S saw the
Bark Mize did not speak her latter part good
wether moderate winds from the W & W standing
to the S & W on the wind
Lat 29° 49' South
Long "

fine wether & light air from the W & W & calm
gained with the Bark George S. Alto latter part
light winds from E & S steering on the wind to
the S & S employed starting down oil

Sunday Mar 15th good wether & light winds
from the E & S steering on the wind to the S & S
7 PM finished starting down oil stored down
48 bbls latter light air from the E & S with rain
lying too under easy sail Lat " " South
Long " " West

Monday March 16th light winds from S
cruising on the wind spoke the Bark Mize
so ends this day Lat 30° 36' South
Long 44° 52' West

Tuesday March 17th fine wether & light wind
cruising on the wind boarded a brig
from Genoa bound to Montevideo

Wednesday March 18th moderate winds
from S cruising spoke the Brk Willis of
Kallapouett Capt Brigh) 5 mi out 15th 9 AM

Thursday March 19th fine wether moderate
breezes from the S starting on diff tacks by the
wind one sail in sight Lat 30° 25' South
Long 44° 25' West

Friday March 20th fine wether cruising
on diff tacks gained with the Brigg
Hale Cory of Westport 2.40 open

Saturday March 21st moderate breezes from
E & S standing to the S
Lat 31° 02' South
Long 41° 13' West

Sunday March 22nd good wether &
strong winds from E standing on
diff tacks spoke the Bark George of
New Bedford 400 ton Lat 31° 42' South
Long 42° 20' West
