Remarks On Board Tuesday March 23rd
This day begins with strong breezes from
S. E. & sailing on the wind under double
reefed topsails. Latter part moderate squalls

Wednesday March 24th begins with a
moderate S. E. gale from the S. E. & latter
moderate breeze from S. E. steering S. E.

Thursday March 25th Strong breezes from S. E.
steering S. E. under easy sail

Lat 30 " 01 South
Long 44 " 51 West

Friday March 26th strong winds from E.
on all tacks by the wind nothing in sight
several this day

Saturday March 27th light winds from
E. & E. on all tacks spoke the Bark Oye
& Bark Aile of this haven

Sunday March 28th light winds from
E. & working to the S. E. at 4 P.M.
Lat 29 " 30 South
Long " " West

Monday Mar 30th begins with light
winds from the E. standing to the
S. E. later strong winds under double reefed
topsails at 10 P.M. saw 3 whales off the
sea bow going quick to the windward at
11 lowered all three boats Lat 28 " 15 South
Long 43 " 30 West

March 31st Strong winds from E. & E.
boats after whales at 1 P.M. all the boats struck
at 5 P.M. got them all along side bay by
them at night. latter strong gales took
the main topsail & turned up the sea boat
mends lying with the whales along side

Tuesday April 1st Strong gales from
E. & E. with a heavy sea running, lying with the
whales along side. Latter part moderate
wind from S. E. with a bad sea on. at 6 A.M.
commenced cutting, so ends cutting under goose
winged main topsail

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Remarks On Board Thursday April 2nd
Strong winds from S. E. at dark finished
cutting middle employed in clearing away
the heads at day light started for work's later
the wind S. E. steering to the E. & boiling

Friday April 3rd fine weather wind from W.
steering to the E. & boiling latter wind S. E. & E.
steering S. E. by E finished boiling

Lat 27 " 41 S
Long 42 " 40 W

Saturday April 4th all these 24 hours
light winds from W. & E. steering
S. E. by E so ends

Sunday April 5th light winds from
S. E. steering E. & E. saw several sails

Monday April 6th light winds from
E. & E. steering to the E. & employed in
stowing down oil Lat 25 " 29 S
Long 38 " 17 W

Tuesday April 7th moderate winds
from E. & E. finished stowing down
standing on all tacks working to the S. E.

Wednesday April 8th light variables
winds working ship to the S. E. & E.
middle & latter part the same, some rain

Thursday April 9th light variables
winds with plenty of rain steering to the
S. E.

Friday April 10th variable winds
with plenty of rain steering to the
S. E. so ends this day

Saturday April 11th Strong variable
winds steering to the S. E. with rain
Lat 18 " 20 S
Long 33 " 03 W

Sunday April 12th light variable wind
steering to the S. E. & E. four sails in sight

Monday April 13th good weather & light winds
from S. E. & E. heading to the E. & E.
Lat 17 " 04 S
Long 33 " 45 W
