

Remarks On Board Saturday June 27th 1863
first & middle strong winds from S.W.
steering N.E. later light variable winds
Lat 36 .. 27 Long 36 .. 27

Sunday June 28th moderate breeze from E.
heading N.E. boarded a French Brigg
bound to Paris Lat 40 .. 27 Long 35 .. 57

Monday June 29th first & middle part fresh
breeze from S.W. heading N.E. later moderate
gale from W. heading N.E.
Lat 41 .. 21 North
Long 35 .. 28 West

Tuesday June 30th fine weather spoke the
Brigg Argo of Sagal & picked up a stick
of Pine timber so ends this day

Wednesday July 1st light variable winds
from all parts of the compass working to the
W. 2nd the Argo in sight
Lat 41 .. 53 North
Long 37 .. 15 West

Thursday July 2nd all these 24 hours light
airs & calm the Argo in sight so ends

Friday July 3rd moderate breezes from N. on
diff. tacks lowered for black fish the Larbird
boat got one

Saturday July 4th light winds from N.
working to the S.W. lowered for black fish &
killers without success gained with the Argo

Sunday July 5th these 24 hours moderate
breezes from N. heading to the W. under short
sail
Lat 39 .. 07 North
Long 40 .. 57 West

Monday July 6th strong winds from W. on
diff. tacks spoke the English Bark Champ
from Trinidad bound to London

Lat 41 .. 07 North
Long 39 .. 38 West

Remarks On Board Tuesday July 7th 1863
moderate breeze from W. steering to the N.E.
through the day & lying by the wind through
the night employed in squaring the rigging
on the fore rigging

Wednesday July 8th light variable winds
working the ship to the N.E. & so ends

Thursday July 9th light winds from South
steering to the E. on diff. tacks one sail in sight

Friday July 10th first & middle thick &
raining attended with thunder & lightning
latter the same steering to the E. under short sail

Saturday July 11th moderate breeze from
N.W. on diff. tacks

Sunday July 12th strong winds from
N.W. heading to the E. under short
sail so ends this day Lat 41 .. 07 North

Monday July 13th first & middle moderate
gales from N.W. under short sail latter more
moderate spoke the Bark Marcella 14 mts
out 560 am & the Brigg Argo
Lat 40 .. 27 North
Long 34 .. 20 West

Tuesday July 14th fine weather wind
from the S.W. commenced with the above
mentioned vessel
Lat 41 .. 37 North
Long 33 .. 50 West

Wednesday July 15th light breezes from the
W. working to the E. Argo in sight

Thursday July 16th light airs & calms
steering S.E. employed in cuping the fore
rigging gained with the Argo

Friday July 17th light airs & calms
steering S.E. employed on the rigging

Saturday July 18th light airs & calms
middle equally steering S.E. at 6 am saw two
distant 40 miles
Lat 39 .. 40 North
Long 31 .. 15 West
