

Remarks On Board Sunday Aug 7th 1863
All these 24 hours light air and calm
two sail in sight Lat 36 " 23 North
Long 35 " 50 West

Monday Aug 10th light breeze from S.W.
on different tacks spoke the bark Millwood
100 Tons this season

Tuesday Aug 11th light breeze from W
on different tacks spoke the bark

Wednesday Aug 12th first part fresh breeze
from N. heading E. coming with the
Millwood & the Middlebarrow latter
fine steering & by 4 four sails in sight

Thursday Aug 13th fresh breeze from
N.W. steering E by S Lat 37 " 34 N
Long 34 " 13 W

Friday Aug 14th first part fresh breeze
from N.W. steering E by S middle
S. latter light breeze

Saturday Aug 15th light variables wind
working to the E saw Blackfish & grampse

Sunday Aug 16th light breeze from S.E. &
at 6 Am made St. Louis bearing N.E.
dis 50 miles Lat 38 " 01 N
Long 31 " 25 W

Monday Aug 17th light winds from E.
& to S.E. steering to the East

Tuesday Aug 18th moderate breeze from S.E.
& E on different tacks by the wind

Wednesday Aug 19th moderate winds from
S.E. on diff tacks by the wind Sagal in sight
to windward

Thursday Aug 20th fresh winds from S.E.
to S.W. on diff tacks Sagal is sight
working up to the land

Remarks On Board Friday Aug 21st 1863
first part fresh breeze from S.W. working up to
stay at 2 Pm the Capt. & boats crew went on
shore at 8 the boat came off the Cape on shore middle
lying off & on at 8 am the boat went on shore
again so ends this day

Saturday Aug 22nd lying off Son at
6 Pm the Capt. came on board & stood out to sea
latter breeze from N.E. heading to the W
the big cargo in sight Lat 38 " 18 N
Long 29 " 02 W

Sunday Aug 23rd light breeze from N.E.
on diff tacks by the wind gained with the
Cargo

Monday Aug 24th strong winds from S.E.
on diff tacks by the wind. Pico in sight
& two sails

Tuesday Aug 25th strong breeze from S.E.
gained with the bark Millwood middle &
latter fine got some provision of her
Lat 38 " 22 N
Long 29 " 41 W

Wednesday Aug 26th light winds from
N.E. & E gained with the Millwood latter
strong winds from E & N.E. Sagal bearing
South dis 8 miles

Thursday Aug 27th strong winds from S.E.
on diff tacks under easy sail land in sight

Friday Aug 28th strong winds from N.
on diff tacks Sagal in sight to leeward kept
off for it, at 10 Am the Capt. went on shore

Saturday Aug 29th light winds from N.E.
& lying off of Son at 4 Pm the Capt. came
off middle & latter light breezes working to the
N on different tacks

Sunday Aug 30th fine breeze from N.E. & W
steering E by N middle by S. with the head
yards aback on the Starboard tack latter strong
winds from E heading S.E. Terceira in sight Dis 6 miles
