Strong breezes from E on diff tacks spoke the
Bark Mattapoisett of Westport Capt Beber

Tuesday Sept 1st fresh breeze from E on diff
tacks by the wind, spoke the Bark Wave Capt
Fishes 300pm, Hayal in sight

Wednesday Sept 2nd moderate breeze from E
to N.E. spoke the Bark Grimezo of Hayal
40pm this season at noon Hayal bearing S.E.
Dis 8 miles sent down the main topsail & repair

Thursday Sept 3rd fine breeze from N.E. &
staring down between Pt George & Graciosa
at noon Terceira S.E. Dis 6 or 7 miles

Friday Sept 4th light airs & calm sent down
the fore topsail & mended it Terceira Dis 10

Saturday Sept 5th all these 24 hours calm
nothing in sight of the whale knoe

Sunday Sept 6th light airs & calm heading
to the S. P. W. Graciosa Dis 7 miles

Monday Sept 7th light winds from N.E.
to E heading to the S. P. W. lowered for grape
with out success
Lat 39 " 06 " N
Long 23 " 27 " W

Tuesday Sept 8th all these 24 hours calm
on lashed the cutting pennant & hared the
eyes of the rigging

Wednesday Sept 9th light airs from N.E.
to N. W. on diff tacks Hayal Dis 18 miles

Thursday Sept 10th light variable winds lower
for blackfish the Starboard boat got one, &
gamed with the Argo Hayal, S. P. W. Dis 10 miles

Friday Sept 11th light winds from E on diff
tacks 4 sails in sight Hayal Dis 10 m

Saturday Sept 12th light airs from E on
diff tacks boiled out the blackfish & spoke
Bark wave, 6 sails in sight

Remarks On Board Sunday Sept 13th 1868
light breeze from E spoke the Bark Roscius Capt
Honeywell 400pm & the Bark Greyhound of Westport
Capt Soule 470 " latter light winds from E to S.E.
heading to the S. P. W. Hayal Dis 8 miles

Monday Sept 14th moderate breeze from E & E
to E heading to the S. P. W. by the wind
Lat 37 " 34 " N
Long 27 " 35 " W

Tuesday Sept 15th moderate breeze from E & E
heading to the S. P. W. so ends this day
Lat 36 " 34 " N
Long 26 " 36 " W

Wednesday Sept 16th light winds from
E to S.E. heading to the S. P. W. & E

Thursday Sept 17th light airs & calms
working to the S. P. W. Lat 36 " 07 " N
Long 25 " 37 " W

Friday Sept 18th light airs from N.W.
heading E & E latter wind from S. P. E to
S. P. W. & thick weather under double reefed,

Saturday Sept 19th fresh breeze from N
to S.E. weather thick & hazy no sails in
sight
Lat 35 " 57 " N
Long 26 " 08 " W

Sunday Sept 20th begins with fresh wind
from E & E heading S.E. spoke the Schooner
Arizona of Provincetown middle & latter on
diff tacks

Monday Sept 21st strong breeze from E
heading to the S. P. W. under short sail

Tuesday Sept 22nd begins with fresh wind
from E & E at night took in sail at 5:30
AM saw 11pm 11 whales going to the windward
at 6 lowered the boats & 8 the West boat
struck the other boats in chase at 11 gave them
up & came on board at noon got the whale on
side
