

Remarks On Board Sunday Nov 15th 1832
first part moderate winds from S. S. W. middle
part moderate gales part of the men on Deck

Monday Nov 16th Strong winds from S. S. W.
attended with heavy squalls of rain let go
the third anchor, latter moderate gale
off recruits

Tuesday Nov 17th begins with heavy
squalls S. S. W. so raged that a boat was
lost and a french ship came in with
mizen mast gone & another one leaking

Wednesday Nov 18th fresh breeze from
off the land at 9 am sent the oil on
shore latter getting ready for sea

Thursday Nov 19th moderate breeze from
S. S. W. at 8 am commenced to heave up the
Larboard anchor at 10 got it on the bow
lying by the moving anchor

Friday Nov 20th moderate breeze from
S. S. W. at 10 pm slipped the chain of the
out to sea by the work passage middle
steering & latter S. S.

Saturday Nov 21st fresh winds from
S. S. W. steering S by E passed the Islands
of St. Michel & St. Marys
Lat 36 .. 44 N
Long 15 .. 07 W

Sunday Nov 22nd moderate breeze
from S. S. W. steering S by E sent up the fore
top galeant yard & sail

Monday Nov 23rd moderate breeze from
S. S. W. steering S bent the studding sails
& set them
Lat 38 .. 53 N
Long 23 .. 12 W

Remarks On Board Tuesday Nov 24th
moderate breeze from S. S. W. steering S took
in the waist boat & repaired it

Wednesday Nov 25th this day begins
with fresh breeze from S. S. W. heading
South

Thursday Nov 26th Strong winds
from S. S. W. steering South under
double reefed topsails

Friday Nov 27th begins with strong
winds from S. S. W. steering S by E
under double reef

Saturday Nov 28th moderate winds
from S. S. W. steering S. S. W. bent a new
Main topsail & repaired the old one
& sent it up forward

Sunday Nov 29th light airs from
S. S. W. steering S by E so ends this
day under all sail
Lat 21 .. 27 N
Long 17 .. 47 W

Monday Nov 30th light winds & calm
steering S. S. W. bent a new Jib

Tuesday Dec 1st light breeze from
S. S. W. steering S by E under all sail so ends this day

Wednesday Dec 2nd begins with light
winds from S. S. W. steering S by E

Thursday Dec 3rd this day begins with
fresh breeze from S. S. W. on Cliff tack
one sail in sight so ends
Lat 18 .. 06 N
Long 19 .. 27 W
