Friday Feb 12th strong breeze from S E steering various courses so ends this day rainy no observation

Sunday Feb 14th strong winds from S E heading to the S W under sheet sail latter more moderate

Monday Feb 15th fine breeze from S E steering various courses nothing in sight so ends this day

Tuesday Feb 16th fresh breeze from S steering at 4 PM raised sperm whales ahead 4 miles off at 5:30 lowered the boats at the waist boat struck at 9 got the whale alongside at 6 AM hooked on to the head at noon got his head off & body in

Wednesday Feb 17th commences with fine weather wind from S E at 12 PM got the junk in at 3 got the case in two whales in sight at 11 PM started the works latter here spot the Bark George
Lat 31 " 30 S

Thursday Feb 18 strong breeze from S employed in boiling spoke the Marcella 50 lbs this season latter on diff tacks the George & Marcella in sight
Lat 31 " 29 S
Long 44 " 11 W

Friday Feb 19th moderate breeze from S on diff tacks boiling at midnight finished boiling at 4 AM heard a whale spouting close to the ship made all sail & steered light airs from S E George in sight saw her pick up a small sperm whale

Saturday Feb 20th commences with fresh breeze from S gamed with the George latter weather thick employed in stowing down oil
