

Remarks On Board Thursday March 10th 1864
light breeze from S.E. steering S.E. by E
under all sail at night. Left the royal
later boarded the English Bark Eugenia
of Yarmouth N.S. Lat 29° 15' South
Long 42° 00' West

Friday March 11th begins with moderate
breeze from S.E. steering S.E. by E
middle wind E.N.E. heading N. later
moderate gale No. 03

Saturday March 12th strong gale from S.E.
giving under glass & reefed main topsail
four different tacks Lat 28° 06' South
Long 42° 23' West

Sunday March 13th first part strong breeze
from W heading S.E. by E under full sail
middle & latter light airs Lat 27° 30' S
Long 41° 15' W
By sun 41° 34' W

Monday March 14th begins with light breeze
from S.W. steering S.E. by E. latter strong
breeze from S.E. took in the light sails
Lat 26° 49' South
Long 39° 35' West

Tuesday March 15th first part fresh breeze from
S.E. steering S.E. by E middle & latter light
variables Lat 25° 37' South
Long 38° 36' West

Wednesday March 16th moderate breeze
from S.E. to S.S.E. steering S.E. by E. four gale
in sight so ends this day Lat 24° 00' South
Long 36° 55' West

Thursday March 17th three 24 hours strong
breeze from S.E. to S.S.E. steering S.E. by E
took in the light sails so ends
Lat 21° 38' South
Long 34° 49' West

Remarks On Board Friday March 18th 1864
strong wind from S.E. steering S.E. 3 sails
in sight so ends this day Lat 18° 11' S
Long 34° 00' W

Saturday March 19th begins with moderate
breeze from S.E. steering S.E. by E
middle & latter light variables employed
in washing the ship outside Lat 18° 53' S
Long 33° 40' W

Sunday March 20th light airs & calms
working to the S.W. Lat 18° 02' S
Long 32° 08' West

Monday March 21st moderate breeze from
N.W. heading E.N.E. stowed the empty
casks and filled them with salt water
Lat 17° 49' South
Long 31° 00' West

Tuesday March 22nd moderate breeze
from S.W. heading to the S.W. washed
ship inside Lat 17° 09' South
Long 32° 24' West

Wednesday March 23rd light breeze from
S.W. on different tacks reefed a new
fore topmast staysail & repaired the
sparker Lat 16° 40' South
Long 32° 40' West

Thursday March 24th all three 24 hours
light fair from S.W. working to the S
Lat 16° 26' South
Long 33° 00' West

Friday March 25th light airs and calms
working to the S. sent the sails that
came from the mizen forward
Lat 15° 50' South
Long 33° 24' West
