Sunday Jan 7th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & moderate breeze R.H. steering by the wind on different tack. finished cutting at 2 P.M. mid & latter parts strong breeze saw 1 sail to day so ends this day

Monday Jan 8th. First of these 24 hours hazy weather & a strong breeze from N.W. R.H. steering by the wind mid & latter parts wind from the westward so ends

Tuesday Jan 9th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & a strong breeze from the westward R.H. steering by the wind saw 2 sail & several Fin backs at night shortened sail mid & latter parts weather much the same boards employed taking out & storing down so ends this day

Saturday Jan 13th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & fresh breeze from the Northward R.H. steering by the wind on different tack saw one sail at night shortened sail mid & latter part weather much the same so ends this day Lat 33.30 Long 8.02

Sunday Jan 14th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light air from the Northward R.H. steering different courses saw 2 sail at night shortened sail mid & latter parts weather much the same saw 3 sail so ends this day Lat 33.51 Long 8.00

Monday Jan 15th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light N.E. wind R.H. steering different courses gained with the R.H. No wind this afternoon mid & latter parts calm saw 3 sail to day & a school of Blackfish so ends this day Lat 34.10 Long 8.32
