Monday
Feb 12th First of these 24 hours fine weather & moderate breeze from NW. B. H. steering E. N. E. at 4 hours. P. M. raised Delphinus whale heading W. lowered for him & the S. H. went on & struck the W. H. struck second Boat killed him & took him to the ship mid part equally latter part strong breeze with big sea running hooked on to our whale at 5. A. M. & began cutting so ends this day on Oct

Tuesday
Feb 13th First of these 24 hours fine weather & a fresh breeze & heavy swell got our whale all in speckling the case that we left a long side mid & latter parts fine weather baled our case to day so ends this day Lat 30.19 Long 44.35

Wednesday
Feb 14th First of these 24 hours fine weather & variable wind hands employed cutting further boiling mid part much the same latter part rainy so ends this day Lat 30.18 Long 44.43

Thursday
Feb 15th First of these 24 hours fine weather & variable wind B. H. steering by the wind hands employed boiling mid part much the same saw 3 sail to day so ends this day Lat 30.15 Long 44.16

Friday
Feb 16th First of these 24 hours light wind & calm finished boiling at 5. P. M. mid & latter parts light S. E. wind saw several Fin backs to day so ends this day Lat 29.32 Long 44.06

Saturday
Feb 17th First of these 24 hours fine weather & light S. E. wind B. H. steering by the wind saw several Fin backs mid & latter parts light wind & calms saw one sail to day hands employed backing out & coopersing Bread & Flour so ends this day Lat 30.00 Long 44.02

Feb 18th First of these 24 hours fine weather & calm hands employed pumping water out of the ground tier mid & latter parts heavy squalls of rain hands employed storing down oil so ends this day no Oct

Monday
Feb 19th First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & strong breeze from the Southward finished storing down our oil at 2. P. M. mid & latter parts strong breeze saw a number of Fin backs to day so ends this day Lat 29.42 Long 45.20

Tuesday
Feb 20th First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & strong breeze from the Northward mid & latter parts fine weather & Easterly wind saw a large break to day ran for it but never saw it again also saw 4 rumpuses & one sail so ends this day Lat 28.26 Long 45.24

Wednesday
Feb 21st First of these 24 hours fine weather & light breeze from the Eastward B. H. steering by the wind on different tacks saw 4 rumpuses at night shortened sail mid & latter parts weather much the same so ends this day Lat 28.18 Long 45.56

Thursday
Feb 22nd First of these 24 hours fine weather & a fresh breeze from the Eastward B. H. steering by the wind on different tacks saw quite a number of rumpuses this afternoon mid & latter parts weather much the same so ends this day Lat 28.48 Long 46.10

Friday
Feb 23rd First of these 24 hours hazy weather & strong breeze from the Eastward B. H. steering by the wind on different tacks mid & latter parts weather much the same so ends this day Lat 28.34 Long 46.44
