the same at 6 hours. And raised the Island of Jökna
so ends this day Lat 11.59 Long 44.31

August 2nd

Thursday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light variable wind
at 10 hours. Am come to. Anchor in 18 fathoms water
mid & latter parts weather much the same hands busily employed
setting up shooks so ends this day

August 3rd

Friday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light variable wind
hands busily employed about decks mid & latter parts weather
much the same got off a raft of water to day so ends this day

August 4th

Saturday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light variable winds
hands employed stowing down water mid & latter parts weather
much the same got off a miter raft of water to day so ends this day

August 5th

Sunday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light variable wind
mid & latter parts squally so ends this day one of our men
deserted to day. Boatmen wear by name

Aug 6th

Monday. First of these 24 hours. Passing showers & variable wind
mid & latter parts fine weather so ends this day

Aug 7th

Tuesday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light wind hands employed
in various jobs about decks mid & latter parts weather much
the same went on shore & caught our men so ends

Aug 8th

Wednesday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & variable winds
hands employed in various jobs about decks mid & latter
parts weather much the same so ends this day

Thursday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light S.E. wind hands
employed in various jobs about decks mid & latter parts weather much
the same so ends this day

Aug 10th

Friday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light variable wind hands

same so ends this day

Aug 11th

Saturday. First of these 24 hours fine weather light wind & calms
not much going on about decks mid & latter parts weather much
the same one of our men deserted last night so ends this day to King

Aug 12th

Sunday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light winds hands variously
employed about decks so ends this day Charls & Sage deserted from
the ship last night

Aug 13th

Monday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light S.E. wind mid & latter
parts much the same got off a small raft of water to day so ends

Aug 14th

Tuesday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light variable winds
at 6 hours. Am took on. Anchor went to bed so ends this day
Lat 12.02 Long 54.06

Aug 15th

Wednesday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & S.E. wind W.R. steering
A sail in sight also saw a school of blackfish mid & latter
parts much the same so ends this day Lat 11.02 Long 43.04

Aug 16th

Thursday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & S.E. wind W.R. steering
A.B.W. saw a school of blackfish mid & latter parts much the
same hands employed repairing foresail so ends this day
Lat 10.31 Long 41.58
