Remarks While on board Bark *Santiago* 1878

March 5th

Thursday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & westerly wind Bark taking in cargo mid & latter parts the same so ends this day

March 6th

Thursday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & westerly wind Bark taking in cargo mid & latter parts weather much the same so ends this day

March 7th

Thursday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & northwesterly wind finished taking in cargo at 2 hours. Put at 6 P.M. took over. Anchor and went to sea mid & latter parts the same so ends

March 8th

Friday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & moderate breeze from the Northward Bark steering N by E mid & latter parts weather the same so ends this day

March 9th

Saturday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & northerly wind Bark steering N by E hands variously employed about decks mid & latter parts the same so ends this day

March 10th

Sunday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light variable wind Bark steering N by E hands employed in ships duty mid & latter parts calm so ends this day

March 11th

Monday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light air Bark steering N by E mid & latter parts southerly wind so ends this day

March 12th

Tuesday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light air from S.W. Bark steering by the wind heading S.E. mid & latter parts light variable wind hands busily employed about decks and in the rigging so ends this day

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March 13th

Wednesday. First of these 24 hours passing squalls & variable winds Bark steering by the wind on different tacks with some rain mid & latter part the same so ends this day

March 14th

Thursday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light wind from S.W. Bark steering by the wind heading S.E. mid part calm latter part light variable wind hands busily employed about decks & in the rigging so ends this day

March 15th

Friday. First of these 24 hours fine weather and light air from E.S.E. Bark steering N by E hands employed making & splicing and other jobs mid & latter parts weather much the same so ends this day

March 16th

Saturday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light variable wind Bark steering S.S.E. hands busily employed about decks and a few stowaways to day mid & latter parts much rain so ends this day

March 17th

Sunday. First of these 24 hours calm not much going on about decks mid & latter parts the same so ends this day

March 18th

Monday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light air from S.E. & Bark steering by the wind heading S.S.W. mid & latter parts light & variable winds hands busily employed so ends this day

March 19th

Tuesday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light wind from S.E. & Bark steering by the wind heading S.S.W. hands variously employed mid & latter parts much the same so ends this day

March 20th

Wednesday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & moderate breeze from the Eastward Bark steering S.S.E. hands employed in the rigging at 11 hours Put out a sail heading to the Northward at 11. A.M. saw a not her one heading the same way so ends this day Lat 12.00 N
