

Remarks on board B H Robert. Morrison 1880

- Wednesday
April 14th First of these 24 hours hazy weather & moderate breeze weighed anchor and went as far as Gaspoint Cove then came to anchor in 8 fathoms water so ends
- Thursday
April 15th First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & light wind weighed anchor to day but soon dropped it again
- Friday
April 16th First of these 24 hours fine weather at 9 AM took air. Anchor and went to sea mid & latter parts thick fog and continued so through out the day so was steamer steering to the North so ends
- Saturday
April 17th First of these 24 hours frequent squalls hands employed getting the boats ready saw one steamer mid & latter parts much the same so ends this day
Lat 39.11
- Sunday
April 18th First of these 24 hours strong breezes from the Westward Bark steering S E by E mid & latter parts much the same at 4 AM raised small whales going quick to windward made sail in chase so ends this day Lat 36.48 Long 66.36
- Monday
April 19th First of these 24 hours strong & variable wind at 1 PM lowered for the waler L H went on and started at one but did not get fast it being a poor chance soon after the W steamer killed him & took him to the ship mid & latter parts fine weather with a heavy sea running at half past 4 PM began cutting and finished at 11 AM so ends

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- Monday
April 20th First of these 24 hours fine weather & light variable winds hands employed cutting blubber mid and latter parts light winds from S W saw one sail so ends
Lat 37.26 Long 63.26
- Tuesday
April 21st First of these 24 hours fine weather hands employed cutting mid part strong breezes latter part blowing a gale from N E with heavy rain finished trying out to day so ends this day
- Wednesday
April 22nd First of these 24 hours blowing a gale from N E with much rain ship lay in to the starboard tack mid part weather much the same latter part fine weather ship steering different courses saw 2 sail to day so ends
Lat 36.50 Long 62.51
- Thursday
April 23rd First of these 24 hours fine weather & N W wind Bark steering S E hands employed in various jobs boat decks mid & latter parts weather much the same saw one sail to day so ends this day Lat 36.05 Long 61.45
- Friday
April 24th First of these 24 hours fine weather & W W winds Bark steering different courses mid & latter parts strong breezes from the Westward Bark steering S by S Lat 35.58 Long 60.08
- Saturday
April 25th First of these 24 hours hazy weather & strong westerly wind at dark luffed to the wind heading S W mid part much the same so ends this day
- Sunday
April 26th First of these 24 hours hazy foggy weather with rain hands variously employed boat decks so ends this day no obs
