June 1st
Tuesday First of these 24 hours fine weather & Northerly
wind R H steering by the wind saw a Steamer
& two sail at dark shortened sail mid & latter
parts the same so ends this day Lat 28 58 Long 52.31

June 2nd
Wednesday First of these 24 hours fine weather & a
moderate breeze from N E R H steering by
the wind hands employed in various jobs
about decks mid & latter parts the same so ends
Lat 29.32 Long 51

June 3rd
Thursday First of these 24 hours fine weather & light N E
wind R H steering by the wind picked up a bbl
of Pol no oil or tallow could not tell which at dark
shortened sail mid & latter parts the same one sail
in sight so ends this day Lat 28.50 Long 51.28

June 4th
Friday First of these 24 hours fine weather and light wind
from N E R H steering different courses at night
gained with the R H E B Phillips Capt Francis
mid & latter parts calms so ends this day Lat 28.53

June 5th
Saturday First of these 24 hours fine weather & light air
from N E R H steering by the wind gained with
E B Phillips and got two more from her mid & latter
parts calms lowered the Boats for a fireman but
did not get fast to them so ends this day
Lat 30.01 Long 53.36

June 6th
Sunday First of these 24 hours fine weather & light air from
N W R H steering by the wind one sail in sight
mid & latter parts strong breezes so ends this day
Lat 30.47 Long 52.98

with Brig D. A Small of Providence toward Capt Carrine
one year out 400 bbls & per mid mid & latter parts light
variable winds hands employed in baking out &
Coopering our oil so ends this day no Obs

Tuesday
June 8th First of these 24 hours fine weather & light air
from the Eastward R H steering N by W finished
our oil at 3 P.M. at dark shortened sail mid & latter
parts the same so ends this day Lat 31.20 Long 52.19

Wednesday
June 9th First of these 24 hours fine weather & westerly winds
R H steering N by W saw a sail & some gunniffers
to day mid & latter parts strong breezes from N W so ends
Lat 33.00 Long 53.04

Thursday
June 10th First of these 24 hours fine weather & a strong
breeze from the westward R H steering N by W
at dark shortened sail mid part fine weather
latter part strong breeze so ends Lat 34.23 Long 53.52

Friday
June 11th First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & a strong breeze
from N W R H steering by the wind at night
shortened sail mid & latter parts weather much the
same so ends this day Lat 35.02 Long 54.34

Saturday
June 12th First of these 24 hours cloudy weather with some rain
R H steering by the wind on different tacks at dark
shortened sail mid & latter parts fine weather saw
a ramprasser to day so ends this day
Lat 34.34 Long 54.54
