Friday  
June 25<sup>th</sup>. First of these 24 hours blowing a gale from  
N W with much rain B K laying to under  
close reefed main topsails & staysails mid  
& latter parts weather more moderate saw Porpoises  
to day Lewis Parker & Joseph & her maid off duty sick  
so ends this day Lat 34.56 Long 48.06

Saturday  
June 26<sup>th</sup>. First of these 24 hours haze & weather & strong  
breeze from the westward B K steering by the wind  
at night shortened sail mid & latter parts the same  
so ends Lat 33.27 Long 47.48

Sunday  
June 27<sup>th</sup>. First of these 24 hours haze & weather and a good  
breeze from the westward B K steering by the  
wind at dark shortened sail mid & latter parts the same  
Lewis Parker & Joseph & her maid off duty sick  
so ends this day Lat 32.18 Long 47.26

Monday  
June 28<sup>th</sup>. First of these 24 hours fine weather & a moderate  
breeze from the westward B K steering by the  
wind and different tracks at dark shortened sail mid part  
the same latter part frequent rain squalls so ends no other

Tuesday  
June 29<sup>th</sup>. First of these 24 hours frequent squalls of wind  
& rain B K steering by the wind saw Porpoises at  
dark shortened sail mid & latter parts the same  
put Charles Smith in Irons to day for misconduct  
he being insolent and I find by inquiry that he has  
been trying to persuade others of the crew to refuse  
duty but did not succeed it seems that he had been  
up all night and had tried in several ways to quarrel  
with the crew forward and had been walking the deck  
with a death knife & razor but it was not reported till  
after he was in Irons. so ends this day  
Lat 32.57 Long 48.13

Wednesday  
June 30<sup>th</sup>. First of these 24 hours fine weather & southward by wind  
B K steering N. W. at dark shortened sail & luffed to the  
wind mid part the same latter part squalls so ends  
this day Lat 33.06 Long 48.18 spoke schooner

Thursday  
July 1<sup>st</sup>. First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & a strong  
breeze from N. W. B K steering N. E. by E mid part  
light breeze latter part variable wind & passing showers  
so ends this day Lat 32.36 Long 46.48

Friday  
July 2<sup>nd</sup>. First of these 24 hours light variable winds &  
calm with passing showers saw one sail to day  
mid & latter parts fine weather so ends this day  
Lat 31.12 Long 45.28

Saturday  
July 3<sup>rd</sup>. First of these 24 hours fine weather & North by E  
winds B K steering different course saw one  
sail mid & latter parts the same so ends this day  
Lat 30.58 Long 46.23

Sunday  
July 4<sup>th</sup>. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light  
variable winds & calm saw one sail at dark shortened  
sail mid & latter parts calm saw Killers so ends  
Lat 30.48 Long 46.31

Monday  
July 5<sup>th</sup>. First of these 24 hours fine weather & calm mid  
& latter parts light Easterly wind saw two spots to day  
saw for it but never saw them again also saw a steamer  
Joseph & her maid & Lewis Parker off duty sick  
Charles Smith still in Irons so ends this day  
Lat 31.23 Long 46.04
