July 7th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light variable winds & calm saw Porpoises & one sail at dark shortened sail mid & latter part the same saw Grampuses to day so ends this day

Thursday
July 8th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light breeze from N.E. R.B. steering N.W. by W picked up a large stick of timber to day mid & latter parts calm sounds

Friday
July 9th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & calm hands employed washing ship out side saw Grampuses today also saw turtle lowered & got him mid & latter parts the same saw a number of sail to day Joseph Smith & Lewis Parker off duty sick sounds Lat 32.09 Long 48.11

Saturday
July 10th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & moderate breeze from N.W. R.B. steering by the wind saw a strainer & several sail also saw jumpers mid & latter parts the same. Andrew Cooper Boatsteerer off duty sick so ends this day Lat 33.03 Long 47.46

Sunday
July 11th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light N.W. winds R.B. steering by the wind mid & latter parts the same so ends this day

July 13th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light westerly winds R.B. steering by the wind saw Porpoises today mid & latter parts the same saw a beach went for it but never saw it again so ends this day Lat 35.06 Long 48.47
Andrew Cooper came on duty to day

Wednesday
July 14th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & westerly winds R.B. steering by the wind saw Hallers & Porpoises mid & latter parts fresh breeze so ends this day
Lat 35.25 Long 49.50

Thursday
July 15th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & strong breeze from the Southward R.B. steering by the wind saw jumpers at dark shortened sail mid & latter parts strong breeze from N.W. so ends Joseph & Hermard off duty sick Charles Smith still in Irons
Lat 36.00 Long 50.21

Friday
July 16th. First of these 24 hours hazy weather & strong breeze from N.W. R.B. steering by the wind saw several sail to day at dark shortened sail mid & latter parts moderate breeze so ends Lat 36.35 Long 49.19

Saturday
July 17th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & a fine breeze from N.W. R.B. steering by the wind mid & latter parts the same so ends this day
