

Remarks On board H. H.

Thursday

Oct 14th. First of these 24 hours comes with cloudy weather & heavy squalls of wind & rain. H. H. steering S. W. by S. mid & latter parts calms so ends this day Joseph & Hermann go for Looper off duty sick. Lat 15.52

Friday

Oct 15th. First of these 24 hours hazy weather & light. Noct hardly wind H. H. steering S. W. by S. at one hour. Pm raised the Island of Fogo at dark luffed to the wind & hoisted aback. Second bearing S. W. 2.5 miles distant mid & latter parts weather the same kept S. dip off for Brazil at 5. Am and at 9 lowered & boat and the Capt went on shore so ends this day

Saturday

Oct 16th. First of these 24 hours hazy weather & strong N. E. wind H. H. laying off & on the boat came off at 1. Pm mid & latter parts the same sent the boat in again at 3. Am and so ends this day Lat 15.04

Sunday

Oct 17th. First of these 24 hours blowing fresh from N. E. H. H. laying off & on it being so rugged the boat did not come off to day mid & latter parts more moderate the boat came off at 9. Am and went on shore again at 10 Joseph & Hermann go for Looper went on shore in the boat so ends this day no obs

Monday

Oct 18th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & variable wind H. H. laying off & on the Capt came off at 4. Pm and squared away Joseph & Hermann go for Looper one two sick men stoped on shore shipped at 3rd Mate & Mr. Armes also pitched off to men and a boy

Oct 19th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & Northwesterly winds. Bark under all sail steering S. saw a sail to day hands busy employed boat decks also saw a few blackfish mid & latter parts S. W. by S. of wind & rain so ends this day Lat 12.08

Wednesday Oct 20th. First of these 24 hours light & variable winds & calms with plenty of rain one sail in sight mid & latter parts the same so ends this day Lat 12.01 Long 22.51

Thursday

Oct 21st. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light winds from W. S. W. North steering S. hands busy employed boat decks mid part equally latter parts fine weather saw one sail so ends this day Lat 11.15 Long 22.47

Friday

Oct 22nd. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light variable winds H. H. steering S. N. E. by E the wind mid & latter parts raining so ends this day Lat 9.57 Long 22.27

Saturday

Oct 23rd. First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & variable wind H. H. steering S. by S the wind employed setting up main topmast rigging mid part raining latter parts fine weather so ends this day Lat 9.11 Long 21.44

Sunday

Oct 24th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light variable winds H. H. steering S. saw a school of blackfish to day latter parts the same so ends Lat 8.36 Long 21.13

Monday

Oct 25th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light air from the E. astward H. H. steering S. lowered the boats to day to protect the men mid part fine latter parts raining so ends this day Lat 7.37 Long 20.50
