NW so ends this day Lat. 38.01 Long 27.18

Sunday
Dec 26th. First of these 24 hours blowing fresh from
the Westward R.R. steering S. by E
mid parts light variable wind latter part blowing
fresh from the Eastward so ends this day one sailed right
Lat. 39.14 Long 30.08

Monday

reefed main topsail & staysails used & latter

by the wind in other board took middle later foote
light winds so ends this day Soot 36.49 Song 43 43

 Jan 2nd First of these 24 hours fine weather & moderate
 breeze from N.E. R.R. steering N.E. by E saw sulphur bottoms
 & Grampians mid & latter parts thick & rainy
