March 16th First of these 24 hours fine weather & light variable winds hands employed brackening out & stowing down after hatch mid part the same latter part raining so ends

Friday
March 17th First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & variable winds hands employed brackening out. Provisions & Coopering them mid & latter parts the same so ends this day

Saturday
March 18th First of these 24 hours fine weather & S.W. wind finished Coopering over provisions to day mid part weather the same latter part strong breeze so ends this day

Sunday
March 19th First of these 24 hours fine weather & S.W. wind mid & latter parts the same so ends this day

Monday
March 20th First of these 24 hours fine weather & S.W. wind mid & latter parts weather much the same sent a raft of bark ashore to day for water

Tuesday
March 21st First of these 24 hours fresh breeze from S.W. hands employed in various jobs sent deck mid & latter parts the same hands painting ship so ends this day

Wednesday
March 22nd First of these 24 hours fine weather & Southwardly wind hands employed filling water & painting ship mid & latter parts weather the same got off a raft of water today so ends

Thursday
March 23rd First of these 24 hours fine weather & Easterly wind stowed our raft of water & sent the bark in for another raft mid & latter parts the same sent our boats crew on liberty to day so ends this day shipped two more to day & being come on board there names are Lewis & Allen back & Thomas. Merchant

March 24th First of these 24 hours fine weather & light Easterly wind hands employed watering and doing other jobs sent the boat in at night for liberty mid but Lewis. Parker & Thomas. Merchant & John. Richardson did not come off and I think have deserted mid & latter parts weather much the same let our other boats crew go on shore to day so ends this day

Saturday
March 25th First of these 24 hours fine weather & light variable wind hands employed in various jobs sent deck got off a raft of water to day at dark sent the boat and for the liberty men they all came off but 2 more forward & no boatmen the boatmen David. Lussie & some refused to come & was locked up the other two deserted there names are ~~Albion. Henderson~~ & William. Johnson mid & latter parts the same took David. Lussie on board so ends

Sunday
March 26th First of these 24 hours fine weather & S.W. wind got off our last raft of water from shore to day & sent our boats crew ashore on liberty mid & latter parts the same at sunset went after the men but 3 had deserted James. Freeman. John. and William. & Bonumman & James. Dixon mid & latter parts the same let our other boats crew go on shore to day so ends this day

Monday
March 27th First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & N.E. wind at night the liberty men all came off mid & latter parts weather much the same so ends this day

Tuesday
March 28th First of these 24 hours fine weather & light variable winds hands employed in various jobs sent deck sent down rope & yard & repaired fastropes to day mid & latter parts weather the same so ends this day

Wednesday
March 29th First of these 24 hours fine weather & Southwardly wind hands employed in various jobs sent deck mid & latter parts raining so ends this day
